BSPS Ridden Tiny Tots Classes

These classes are open to both members & non members. All ponies in this section must be shown in a snaffle bridle. These classes are open to Show Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies & Pure bred Mountain & Moorland ponies. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 1 TEENY TINY TOTS LEAD REIN (walk only)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any type of pony not exceeding 128cm. This class will be a walk only class
- Riders aged 5 years of age or under.
- Leaders must be 16 years and over
- Leading Rein is to be attached onto the noseband. A handle on the saddle is permitted.

CLASS 2 THE BSPS TINY TOTS LEAD REIN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- The handler must be 16 years or over
- The lead rein must be attached to the noseband. Handles on the saddle are allowed

CLASS 3 THE BSPS TINY TOTS WALK & TROT

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- This class will be walk & trot only. There will be no change of rein on the go round.

CLASS 4 THE BSPS TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- On the go round ponies will not be asked to change the rein.
- In their individual shows ponies will be expected to walk up, trot back, cantering is optional but no figure of eight or change of rein is required.
- The judge will be looking for a pony suitable to take its rider safely off the lead rein at all times

CLASS 5 THE BSPS TINY TOTS RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- Ponies will be asked to canter in their individual show only.

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

SHOW PONIES MINIS

These classes are open to both members & non members. **Ponies to be shown plaited with velvet browbands**. Riders would usually wear a navy show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 6 THE BSPS OPEN LEAD REIN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st of January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- The leading rein must be attached onto the noseband. Leaders to be 16yrs or over.

CLASS 7 THE BSPS OPEN FIRST RIDDEN PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st of January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- There is no cantering on the go round.

BSPS Show Pony Mini Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

SHOW HUNTER MINI PONIES

These classes are open to both members & non members. **Ponies to be shown plaited with plain browbands** and a snaffle bridle. Riders would usually wear a tweed show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 8 THE BSPS OPEN LEAD REIN PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- This is NOT a handy pony competition but in their individual shows ponies may be asked to negotiate a small obstacle.
- The leading rein must be attached onto the noseband. Leaders to be 16yrs or over.

CLASS 9 THE BSPS OPEN FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.
- No cantering except for individual performance. Ponies must leave the ring at walk or trot.

BSPS Show Hunter Pony Mini Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

BSPS NOVICE RIDDEN CLASSES

Open to both members & non members. **All animals in this section are to be shown plaited**. No lead reins are eligible. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 10 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 148cm. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their * birthday before 1st Jan in the current year (see below)
 - Not exceeding 128cm / 13 years
 - 128cm-138cm / 15 years

138cm-148cm / 17 years

CLASS 11 THE BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONY

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cm. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their * birthday before 1st Jan in the current year (see below)
 - Not exceeding 122cm / 12 years
 - 122cm-133cm / 14 years
 - 133cm-143cm / 17 years
 - 143cm-153cm / 20 years

CLASS 12 THE BSPS NOVICE MIXED HEIGHT INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE / SHOW HUNTER

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cm but not exceeding 158cm.
- Riders must not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year

Young Handlers

CLASS 13 YOUNG HANDLERS – 5 to 8 YEARS OF AGE

- Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, any height of pony. Handlers 5 to 8 years of age.
- To be judged purely on handler skills and not conformation.

CLASS 14 YOUNG HANDLERS - 9 TO 12 YEARS OF AGE

- Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, any height of pony. Handlers 9 to 12 years of age.
- To be judged purely on handler skills and not conformation.

Young Handler Championship

1st & 2nd in the above section are invited to come forward

The champion & reserve are *not* eligible for supreme of show

Best Combination Ridden Classes

These classes are open to both members & non members. The classes in this section are open to any type of horse or pony. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 15 NOVICE WALK & TROT RIDDEN PONY

Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, any type not exceeding 148cm. Rider under 18.

CLASS 16 YOUNG RIDERS

- Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, any type of pony not exceeding 148cm
- Rider aged 12 years of age or under.

CLASS 17 NEW COMBINATION

- Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, any type. Rider any age.
- Combination must be within their first 12 months of partnership together

CLASS 18 NOVICE WALK & TROT RIDDEN HORSE

Mare of gelding 4 years old or over, any type exceeding 148cm. Rider any age.

Best Combination Championship

1st & 2nd in this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for supreme of show

HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND MINI PONIES NOVICE

These classes are open to both members & non members. Ponies to be shown in their natural state with plain browbands and snaffle bridles. Riders would usually wear a tweed show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 19 BSPS "HERITAGE" M&M NOVICE LEAD REIN

- Registered pure-bred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cm.
- No stallions permitted
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- The leading rein must be attached to the noseband & leaders be over 16 years of age

CLASS 20 "HERITAGE" M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN

- Registered pure-bred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms.
- No stallions permitted
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the first January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.

BSPS Heritage M&M Mini Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND MINI PONIES OPEN

These classes are open to both members & non members. Ponies to be shown in their natural state with plain browbands and snaffle bridles. Riders would usually wear a tweed show jacket. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 21 BSPS "HERITAGE" M&M OPEN LEAD REIN

- Registered pure-bred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cm.
- No stallions permitted
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class
- The leading rein must be attached to the noseband & leaders be over 16 years of age

CLASS 22 "HERITAGE" M&M OPEN FIRST RIDDEN

- Registered pure-bred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms.
- No stallions permitted
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the first January in the current year. Riders must be over 3yrs in this class.

BSPS Heritage M&M Mini Championship

1st & 2nd place winners from this section are invited to come forward

Champion & Reserve are eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

HERITAGE M&M NOVICE PONIES

Ponies are to be shown unplaited in their natural state. Riders would usually wear tweed jackets however any show jacket is acceptable for this show. This section is not open to lead reins. A snaffle bridle must be worn. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 23 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN – Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland

• Registered pure-bred, 4 years old or over. Rider any age

CLASS 24 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN – Welsh A & B

• Registered pure-bred, 4 years old or over. Rider any age

CLASS 25 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN – Welsh C & D

• Registered pure-bred, 4 years old or over. Rider any age

CLASS 26 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN – New Forest & Connemara

• Registered pure-bred, 4 years old or over. Rider any age

CLASS 27 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN – Fell, Highland & Dales

Registered pure-bred, 4 years old or over. Rider any age

WINTER WORKER STAKES

These classes are open to both members & non members and to both Plaited and Heritage Mountain & Moorland Animals. Points will be awarded on the following;

Jumping 70 Marks
Style whilst jumping 30 Marks
Conformation & Way of Going 20 Marks
Total Marks Awarded 120 Marks

The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. Ponies may compete in more than one height section.

CLASS 28 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES - 60CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride

CLASS 29 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 70CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride

CLASS 30 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 80CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride

Winter Worker Stakes Championship

1st & 2nd in this section are eligible to come forward

Champion & Reserve eligible for Supreme of Show

TINY TOTS WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

These classes are open to both members & non members and suitable for both plaited & unplaited ponies. No balance, grass or side reins may be used

CLASS 31 TEENY TINY TOTS WORKING HUNTER

- Open to any mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cm
- Riders not to have attained their 6th birthday before the first January in the current year.
- All jumps will be cross poles & Lead Reins are welcome to enter this class

CLASS 32 LEAD REIN & ASSISTED WORKING HUNTER

- Open to any mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cm
- Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before the first January in the current year.
- Maximum height of fences 30cm
- Open to both lead reins and those just off the lead rein who may still need some assistance.

CLASS 33 BSPS TINY TOTS STAKES CLASS

- Mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 122cm
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider minimum 3yo and not to have attained their 9th birthday before the first January in the current year.
- Maximum height and spread for fences 40cm

Tiny Tots Working Hunter Championship

1st & 2nd from this section are eligible to compete

Champion & Reserve eligible for Tiny Tots Supreme

BSPS MINI WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

These classes are open to both members & non members. Plaited ponies only. No balance, grass or side reins may be used. No lead reins may enter this section.

CLASS 34 BSPS CRADLE STAKES

- Mare or gelding, 4 years or over not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Height of fences 45-60cm, Spreads 45-60cm

CLASS 35 BSPS NOVICE NURSERY STAKES

- mare or gelding, 4 years or over not exceeding 133cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Maximum height of fences 60cm, Spreads 55cm

CLASS 36 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES

- mare or gelding, 4 years or over not exceeding 133cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Height of fences 70cm, Spreads 70cm

BSPS Mini Working Hunter Championship

1st & 2nd in this section are eligible to come forward

Champion & Reserve eligible for Supreme of Show

Judge:

BSPS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER

These classes are open to both members & non members. Registered pure bred Mountain & Moorland Ponies only. To be shown unplaited. No balance, side or grass reins may be used. No lead reins may enter this section.

CLASS 37 BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN CRADLE STAKES

- Registered pure bred ponies, 4 years or over not exceeding 122cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Maximum height of fences 55cm, spreads 47cm

CLASS 38 BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN NURSERY STAKES

- Registered pure bred ponies, 4 years or over not exceeding 133cm.
- Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- Maximum height of fences 65cm, spreads 50cm

Heritage M&M Mini Working Hunter Championship 1st & 2nd in this section are eligible to come forward Champion & Reserve eligible for Supreme of Show

All Champions and Reserve Champions from the First Ridden, Lead Rein and Tiny Tots sections are invited to come forward for the <u>Tiny Tots Supreme of Show</u>

The Supreme Tiny Tot and Reserve Supreme Tiny Tot are also invited forward to Supreme of Show

Online & postal entries close on Wednesday 16th August at Midnight. Entries will also be taken on the day. An additional £3.50 will be included per rider for First Aid.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All BSPS members and show exhibitors agree to comply with the rules laid out in the current BSPS Rule Book. This includes but is not limited to rules regarding dope testing, good conduct and discipline and the social media and internet policy. It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property. Conditions of Entry & Rules:

- This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- Entry fees are non-refundable if the show must be cancelled due to weather conditions which are out with the control of the BSPS Scottish Branch. Please check website for up to date information on the show. Entries are also not transferable to other riders, ponies or classes.
- EQUINE PASSPORTS/INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATES. Exhibitors are required to have Passports for all
 horses/ponies when competing at the show and up to date Equine Inoculation Certificate for each of their exhibits in
 accordance with the current BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. Any exhibitor found without a passport or valid certificates
 for all their animals will be asked to leave the Showground.
- Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required.
 No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to B.S.P.S. SCOTTISH BRANCH. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
- NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE. Entries cannot be changed, substituted or amended once received.
- OBJECTIONS must be made in writing with the objector's full name and address within 60 minutes of the completion of
 judging and must be lodged at the Secretary's Office together with the sum of £50 deposit. This sum will be returned if
 the objection is sustained, but if the objection is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited. Any objection against the
 judging of a class or championship must be referred to the BSPS in accordance with the Rules in the current BSPS Rule
 and Show Hand Book.

BODY PROTECTORS

- Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organized and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (Purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label manufactured in the year 2009.
- BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline.
- All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

HATS

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)

Judging:

- Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show.
- Classes will be Judged in accordance with the current BSPS Rule Book.
- The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rules by the Judge.
- The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class, championship or supreme as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show.
- No marks will be displayed until after the presentation of awards.

Dope Testing:

Any animal taking part in BSPS Shows or shows affiliated to BSPS are liable to Dope Testing

Trophies

• All Trophy winners must be members of BSPS Scotland. An ADULT must sign for the Trophy, and agree to return when requested by the BSPS Scotland, in a good, clean condition. All breakages will be charged for.

General:

- Only tack and spurs that are permissible in the ring in BSPS classes are allowed on the showground
- Mounted exhibitors must adhere to horse walkways and riding areas.
- Motorised vehicles including scooters are not allowed on the showfields.
- Ponies must not to left overnight in trailers or horseboxes. Coralling is not permitted.
- The current welfare policy will be enforced at every show.
- Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd Show may use the arenas for exercising.

Liability:

- Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.
- BSPS shall not be liable to the show entrants in contract, tort, negligence, breach of statutory duty or otherwise for any
 loss, damage, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever incurred or suffered by the show entrants of an indirect or
 consequential nature including without limitation any economic loss or other loss of turnover, profits, business or
 goodwill. Any notice served in accordance with this clause shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given
 if left at or sent by post or telex or facsimile to the entrant at the address or relevant telecommunications number for such
 entrant or such other address as the entrant may from time to time designate
- It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.

Conduct:

- Rule 67 No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.
- Rule 70 Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by themor assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.

B.S.P.S. QUALIFICATION

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BSPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

<u>Novice</u> – in the novice classes the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} placed animals will qualify. In mixed height novice classes, the 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} and 4^{th} placed ponies will qualify.

<u>Open</u> – in the open (restricted) the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. Riders on restricted animals MUST wear an armband when they enter the ring. In Mixed height Open (restricted) the four highest placed restricted animals will qualify

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. **Animals must NOT have been placed 1**st to 8th at the RIHS or HOYS or in the relevant classes in 2020/2021/2022. Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2022 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 21. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of.

This year's show will be held at Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals.

Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse & Pony except for Adult/Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.
