Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. Ponies may compete in more than one height section.

#### CLASS 1 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES - 60CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. An award card will be presented to the highest placed child under 12 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships

#### CLASS 2 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 70CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider *An award card will be presented to the highest placed child under 14 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships*

#### CLASS 3 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 80CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider *An award card will be presented to the highest placed rider under 18 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships*

#### CLASS 4 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 90CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider *An award card will be presented to the highest placed rider under 18 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships*

#### CLASS 5 BSPS WINTER WORKER STAKES – 100CM

- Plaited or Heritage Mountain & Moorland ponies, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cm
- Riders of any age but must be suitably mounted for the animal they ride
- The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider *An award card will be presented to the highest placed rider under 25 years of age on the day of the show who will also qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships*

BSPS Winter Worker Stakes Championship  $1^{st} \& 2^{nd}$  place winners from Class 1-5 are invited to come forward

#### CLASS 6 BSPS NOVICE INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY (148-158cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m, spreads 95cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 7 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (153cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 95cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 8 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (143cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 85cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 9 BSPS NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year
- Max height of fences 75cm.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

BSPS Novice Working Hunter Pony Championship  $1^{st} \& 2^{nd}$  place holders from Class 6-9 are invited to come forward

#### CLASS 10 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 85cm.
- Animals eligible for the restricted section must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or at Hoys in WHP classes in the current or previous two years. *Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.*
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 11 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY (143cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 143cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 95cms.
- Animals eligible for the restricted section must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or at Hoys in WHP classes in the current or previous two years. *Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband*.
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 12 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) WORKING HUNTER PONY (153cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m.
- Animals eligible for the restricted section must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or at Hoys in WHP classes in the current or previous two years. Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 13 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE WHP (148-158)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 1m 5cm.
- Animals eligible for the restricted section must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or at Hoys in Intermediate WH classes in the current or previous two years. *Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband.*
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

BSPS Winter Open (Restricted) Working Hunter Pony Championship  $1^{st} \& 2^{nd}$  place winners from Class 10-13 are invited to come forward

#### **OPEN MINI WORKING HUNTER PONIES**

#### CLASS 14 BSPS OPEN CRADLE STAKES (122cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 60cm
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### CLASS 15 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES (133cm)

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.
- Riders not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- Max height of fences 70cm.
- Animals eligible for the restricted section must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or at Hoys in WHP classes in the current or previous two years. Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### Class 16 BSPS OPEN NURSERY STAKES CLASS (ROYAL HIGHLAND QUALIFIER)

#### This class is kindly sponsored by Champfleurie Equestrian

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cm. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year
- Maximum height of fences 75cm
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class
- This is a qualifier for the Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2023. The first 4 placed same pony and rider combinations will qualify for the 2023 Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes provided they have jumped a clear round. Qualification will only move down the line to the next eligible pony and rider combination meeting the qualification criteria. Qualification will be in accordance with Rule 37 of the BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. This class is open to both BSPS Members and non members.

- Max height of fences 65cm
- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

- Registered pure bred ponies, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders any age.
- Max height of fences 75cm

- This class is not a winter championship qualifying class

#### **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All BSPS members and show exhibitors agree to comply with the rules laid out in the current BSPS Rule Book. This includes but is not limited to rules regarding dope testing, good conduct and discipline and the social media and internet policy. It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.

#### Conditions of Entry & Rules:

- This Show is Affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not Members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.
- Neither the BSPS Scottish Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property in connection with this Show.
- Entry fees are non-refundable if the show must be cancelled due to weather conditions which are out with the control of the BSPS Scottish Branch. Please check website for up to date information on the show. Entries are also not transferable to other riders, ponies or classes.
- EQUINE PASSPORTS/INFLUENZA VACCINATION CERTIFICATES. Exhibitors are required to have Passports for all horses/ponies when competing at the show and up to date Equine Inoculation Certificate for each of their exhibits in accordance with the current BSPS Rule and Show Handbook. Any exhibitor found without a passport or valid certificates for all their animals will be asked to leave the Showground.
- Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. An S.A.E. must be submitted with entries if a receipt is required. No numbers will be sent to Exhibitors prior to the Show. Competitors' numbers should be collected from the Secretary's Office on the Show Ground. Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to B.S.P.S. SCOTTISH BRANCH. NO entries will be accepted over the telephone.
- NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE. Entries cannot be changed, substituted or amended once received.
- OBJECTIONS must be made in writing with the objector's full name and address within 60 minutes of the completion of
  judging and must be lodged at the Secretary's Office together with the sum of £50 deposit. This sum will be returned if
  the objection is sustained, but if the objection is not sustained the deposit will be forfeited. Any objection against the
  judging of a class or championship must be referred to the BSPS in accordance with the Rules in the current BSPS Rule
  and Show Hand Book.

#### **BODY PROTECTORS**

- Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice ring at B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organized and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (Purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label manufactured in the year 2009.
- BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline.
- All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

#### **HATS**

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via

the Pony Club Scheme. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags)

#### Judging:

- Each Exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the Judges, Referees, Chief Steward and Officials of the Show
- Classes will be Judged in accordance with the current BSPS Rule Book.
- The Judges listed in the Schedule have accepted our invitation to Judge, but the Committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any Judge withdraw.
- No Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a Judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of Rules by the Judge.
- The BSPS Scottish Branch/Board of Directors reserve the right to move, change, amalgamate or divide any class, championship or supreme as they deem fit when necessary to facilitate the running of the show. It is therefore the competitor's responsibility to keep up to date with any changes which may occur during the running of the show.
- No marks will be displayed until after the presentation of awards.

#### Dope Testing:

Any animal taking part in BSPS Shows or shows affiliated to BSPS are liable to Dope Testing

#### **Trophies**

• All Trophy winners must be members of BSPS. An ADULT must sign for the Trophy, and agree to return when requested by the BSPS Scotland, in a good, clean condition. All breakages will be charged for.

#### General:

- Only tack and spurs that are permissible in the ring in BSPS classes are allowed on the showground
- Mounted exhibitors must adhere to horse walkways and riding areas.
- Motorised vehicles including scooters are not allowed on the showfields.
- Ponies must not to left overnight in trailers or horseboxes. Coralling is not permitted.
- The current welfare policy will be enforced at every show.
- Only animals entered in classes at the BSPS Scottish Branch Ltd Show may use the arenas for exercising.

#### Liability:

- Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.
- BSPS shall not be liable to the show entrants in contract, tort, negligence, breach of statutory duty or otherwise for any
  loss, damage, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever incurred or suffered by the show entrants of an indirect or
  consequential nature including without limitation any economic loss or other loss of turnover, profits, business or
  goodwill.Any notice served in accordance with this clause shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given
  if left at or sent by post or telex or facsimile to the entrant at the address or relevant telecommunications number for
  such entrant or such other address as the entrant may from time to time designate
- It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property.

#### Conduct:

- Rule 67 No member of the BSPS shall conduct himself in a manner or be guilty of behaviour which is derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interests of the BSPS and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) no Member shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant matter to any person at any show or at any other location where BSPS business is being transacted or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format. Members' attention is drawn to the BSPS Social Media and Internet Policy set out in the back of the BSPS Handbook.
- Rule 70 Members are responsible for the actions of any non-members who are Family Members (as defined below) or who are friends or friends of Family Members or who are employed by themor assisting, supporting or representing them or otherwise acting on their behalf and any action or conduct of such non-member which would be a breach of the Rules were he a Member shall constitute a breach of the Rules by the Member concerned. Family Member shall include a spouse or civil partner, a partner, a direct descendant or ascendant of the Member or his spouse or civil partner, or any other person who is

part of the same household as the Member or is in the reasonable opinion of the BSPS a member of the Member's family in the widest sense.

#### **THE ROYAL HIGHLAND SHOW – NURSERY STAKES**

This show is a qualifier for The Royal Highland Show Nursery Stakes 2023. #### RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BSPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

<u>Novice</u> – in the novice classes the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed animals will qualify. In mixed height novice classes, the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> placed ponies will qualify.

<u>Open</u> – in the open (restricted) the three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. Riders on restricted animals MUST wear an armband when they enter the ring. In Mixed height Open (restricted) the four highest placed restricted animals will qualify

Animals must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. **Animals must NOT have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at the RIHS or HOYS or in the relevant classes in the current or previous two years.** Please note that this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications. All Rules as per the 2023 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

#### WINTER WORKER STAKES

Open to both plaited or Heritage M&M ponies. The highest placed 3 ponies will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships together with the highest placed junior rider. Ponies may compete in more than one height section.
