Class 35 SHB(GB) NOVICE WORKING HUNTER

A mare, gelding or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old and over not to have won a first prize of £25 or a total of £150 (or equivalent values) in prize money (including championship prize money) in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter Class, or more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the relevant year. Fences in Novice Working Hunter classes should have a minimum height of 0.85m (2'9") and a maximum height of 1.00m (3'3"). Working Hunters may compete 'Hors Concours' in Novice Working Hunter classes in the jumping phase only at the discretion of the show secretary but the horse cannot compete in any other Working Hunter classes for the duration of that show. Any horse that qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or Royal International Horse Show will not be eligible to compete in Novice classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

Class 36 SHB(GB) RESTRICTED WORKING HUNTER

Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years old or over, not to have won a total of £400 (excluding championship prize money) prize money in any Working Hunter class, or more than 25 BE points or 200 BS points at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the current year. Any horse that qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or Royal International Horse Show will not be eligible to compete in Restricted Open Working Hunter classes from 1st January the following year, but horses that qualified for HOYS as a 4 year old are exempt.

Class 37 SHB(GB) OPEN WORKING LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER RIHS QUALIFIER

Animals competing in the following classes will qualify: Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, SHP, Intermediate SH and SRT, and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, and Ridden classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2024 Horse of the Year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

The 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify for the Binks Family Champion of Champions: Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH and SRT, and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, and Ridden Classes.

UK Ponies and Horses Limited

Classes 83-87 are affiliated to UK Ponies & Horses Limited and will be run in accordance with their rules. Owners must be Adult / Life Members, Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Annual Members, and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses Limited before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden – classes 83-86 only. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead in July 2024. Qualification will be verified by the office.

1st, 2nd & 3rd placed competitors in classes 83 to 87 will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Gold Medal Series to take place at Onley in March 2025. Qualification cards are not distributed in the ring, however results can be verified by the office.

BSPA

Classes 65-70 are affiliated to the BSPA. Classes 67-70 are qualifiers for the RIHS 2024. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules – download from www.bspaonline.com. All horse/ponies, owners and riders must be registered with the BSPA prior to the show. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature; No competitor/owner/horse may compete in these classes or enter the ring without a current 2024 membership and qualification card.

Competitors qualifying at this show for the RIHS, must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48hrs of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex, RH17 5NU.

Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate.

All stallions must be graded with the BSPA for 2024 and must wear a 2024 BSPA stallion disc. No rider under 14 years of age may exhibit a stallion in any class.

Rider age will be taken from 1st January.

The first placed and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd will qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

The highest placed amateur and junior in each class will qualify for the amateur and junior supreme championship finals to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2024. Qualification cards to be shown in the ring and signed.

SHB(GB)

Classes 35-38 and 71-77 are affiliated to the Sports Horse Breeding of GB (SHB GB) and will be judged under the Society's Rules – see 2024 [Rule Book](#). All horses, Owners and Riders need to be registered with SHB(GB).

Classes 37, 38, and 72-77 are qualifiers for the RIHS 2024 and only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society. The two highest placed horses in each class will qualify for the RIHS. No horse lower than second in its class will qualify except in the Working Hunter classes where the three highest placed horses will qualify, and in the Amateur ridden hunter classes, where in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. Judges must place all horses to determine qualifiers.

Amateur Ridden Hunter will be run under new 2024 SHB(GB) Rules

Day Ticket = £42 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 1 show in the year at £42 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

BSHA

Classes 39-40 and 48-64 will be held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms.**

DAY TICKETS - Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into Open RIHS (excluding Working Show Horse) or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form or apply online on the BSHA website.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024.

The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2024

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW - Classes 58-64 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Competitors qualifying at this show for the Longines Royal International Horse Show 2023 must submit their entries ONLINE at: www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/longines-fei-jumping-nationscup-of-great-britain-at-the-longines-royal-international-horse-show/

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in

Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

RIHS AMATEUR QUALIFYING CLASSES - Classes 54-58 are qualifiers for the inaugural Amateur Championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse IN EACH SECTION in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship.

Please refer to rules 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook.

RIHS Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.
