Class 3. THE B.S.P.S. (RIHS) HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS. Welsh Section C or D, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 4. THE B.S.P.S. (RIHS) HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS New Forest, Connemara, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 5. THE B.S.P.S. (RIHS) HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND OPEN RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS Fells, Highlands, Dales, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 7. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Heritage Mountain & Moorland First Ridden. Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 9. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PRETTY POLLY FIRST RIDDEN, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms, Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 10. The B.S.P.S Heritage Pretty Polly (RIHS) Ridden Mixed Breeds, Registered Pure Bred Ponies, 4 years old and over. Riders Any age. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B, Connemara, Dales, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D ponies.

The class will be judged as a whole but all ponies will be brought in at a walk and then the class will be divided for the go round into small & large breeds. The two sections will then be lined up together to do the individual show and confirmation and the result will be decided on the highest score achieved.

The 'Top Spec' Supreme 'Pretty Polly' Ridden Championship.

To be competed for by the 1st and 2nd prize winners in all Pretty Polly classes. The Champion will qualify for The 'Top Spec Supreme "Pretty Polly" Ridden Championship. Classes 8 – 10 and 16 - 19.

CLASS 12: The B.S.P.S (RIHS) SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms, Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

MINI SHOW PONY CHAMPIONSHIP 1st Prize winners in classes 11 & 12 and 13-15 will qualify for The BSPS Binks Family 50th Year Golden Anniversary Show Champion of Champions.

CLASS 13 The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Show Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms, Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 14: The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Show Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms and not exceeding 138cms, Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 15: The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Show Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms and not exceeding 148cms, Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 17. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) PRETTY POLLY MIXED HEIGHT SHOW HUNTER PONY. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 18. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) PRETTY POLLY MIXED HEIGHT SHOW PONY. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 19. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) PRETTY POLLY INTERMEDIATE SRT/SHT. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding not exceeding 1 58cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

THE PRETTY POLLY CHAMPIONSHIP WILL BE JUDGED AFTER CLASS 10 IN RING ONE

THE B.S.P.S. (R.I.H.S.) RIDDEN ANGLO AND PART BRED ARAB CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st. and 2nd. Prize winners in the Anglo and Part Bred Arab classes.

The Champion qualifies for The Sandboro Stud Supreme Ridden Part Bred & Anglo Arab Championship to be held at the North of England Summer pony show on 6th July 2019.

Owners and Riders must be BSPS Members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in RIHS Qualifying classes. (Anglo and Part Bred Arabs must be registered with the Arab Horse Society).

Class 23. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 24. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 122cms. And not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 25. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 133cms. And not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 26. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) Open Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms. And not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st prize winners in classes 22-26 and 27-29 will qualify for The BSPS Binks Family 50th Golden Anniversary Show Champion of Champions.

Class 27. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) INTERMEDIATE Show Riding Type. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cms. And not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 28. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) INTERMEDIATE Show Riding Type Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms. And not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 29. The B.S.P.S. (RIHS) INTERMEDIATE S.H. Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms. And not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Championship to be competed for by the 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 27-29. The Champion will qualify for The 'Sporting Sam' Supreme Intermediate Championship & the Champion will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society, and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in these classes whether or not members are subject to the constitution and rules of this society including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of this society. 2. All B.S.P.S. Classes will be judged under the rules in the 2019 B.S.P.S. Rule and Show Handbook. 3. The judge's decision is final. 4. The judges named in this schedule have accepted the invitation to judge but the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge who is unable to attend. 5. No nomination or substitution entries are allowed. 6. No spurs may be worn in B.S.P.S. Classes. 7. Objections should be made in writing with the objector's full name and address, within an hour of the event-taking place, and lodged at the secretary's office with the sum of £10 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained. Any objection in respect of a J.M.B. Certificate will be dealt with in accordance with J.M.B. Rules. 8. The committee shall not, in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the showground or onto any premises in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same. 9. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their assistants or riders and for the conduct of such assistants and riders and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the instructions given by the judges or stewards. No juvenile, mounted or un-mounted will be allowed in collecting ring without adult supervision. 10. This Show is a qualifier for the RIHS. Only one pony in each of the Anglo and part bred Arab or Lead Rein Hunter Type or Open SHP classes or Lead Rein Class or First Ridden Class or Open Intermediate SR, SH, and WH or mixed height Pretty Polly Show Pony, Pretty Polly SHP, Pretty Polly Intermediate SRT/SH. 133 -153 cms SHP, PrettyPolly Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Heritage Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden Classes qualifiers and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in each class will qualify. In the Pretty Polly Heritage Open Ridden Mixed Breeds, the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in the class will qualify. Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. Members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with R.I.H.S. qualification. 11. This show is a qualifier for the 2019 B.S.P.S. Championship Show, to be held at Arena UK. 1st and 2nd prize winners only. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners qualify provided the animal is registered in accordance with rules 21 & 23 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. Member. 12. Ponies must be owned registered and ridden by a B.S.P.S. Member to compete in these classes. 13. In the Intermediate classes riders over 18 years and including 25 years must be showing members. 14. This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Classic Security (UK) Challenge, The highest placed pony in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Intermediates & Heritage classes. Animals must qualify for the challenge by attending any B.S.P.S affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for 2019 Horse of The Year Show in the appropriate class. BSPS Rule 516. 15. All Pretty Polly Classes will be run under B.S.P.S. Pretty Polly rules as laid out in the 2019 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook. 16. Royal International Horse Show. – The R.I.H.S. levy is £9.50 per entry. Owners and rides must be B.S.P.S. Members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with qualification for the R.I.H.S. 17. B.S.P.S. Premier League – Black Country Saddles rider of the Year – The Best Rider in each of the following Open classes at all BSPS Affiliated Shows will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championships Show: - Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, 122, 133, 143, & 153 SHP, Intermediate SRT, SH & Heritage classes. 19. Owners and riders must be BSPS Members to qualify in the RIHS Anglo & Part-bred Arab Classes. Animals must be registered with the AHS – BSPS Rule 522. 20. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS. 21.
