A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider is allowed). Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland. Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 31: The B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

Registered Pure Bred Welsh Sections A and B Ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 32: The B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics Ridden

Registered Pure Bred Welsh Section C. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 33: The B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

Registered Pure Bred Connemara and New Forest. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 34: The B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

Registered Pure Bred Fells, Dales and Highlands. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 35: The B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics Heritage Ridden

Registered Pure Bred Welsh Section D. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

THE B.S.P.S. New Horizon Plastics HERITAGE RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners from the above classes. Animals must be placed to third in every Championship.

The Champion will qualify for BSPS Supreme Heritage at London International Horse Show. If the Champion has already qualified, the Reserve Champion will qualify. If the Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified the 3rd placed animal will qualify.

1st to 3rd prize winners of the individual classes, (with the exception of the pony that has qualified), will qualify to compete at the SEMI-FINAL to be held at THE BSPS HERITAGE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW, at Arena U.K. (The qualification will NOT pass down the line).

These classes are also qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Roger's Truck Services Ltd Challenge , and Ponies that have been placed 1st in open Heritage Classes will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions.

To be judged on a 50/50 marks system.

50 marks - Show/Freedom of Action

50 marks - Breed Type/Conformation

Ponies, Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S Members before the date of the Show to Complete in the London International Horse show Classes. Classes will be judged under B.S.P.S rules as per the 2023 B.S.P.S Rule & Show Handbook. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards.

To be judged on a 50/50 marks system. 50 marks - Show/Freedom of action, 50 marks - Breed Type/Conformation
