CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW

1. The Carmarthenshire Welsh Pony and Cob Association and the Cothi Bridge Showground Trustees, nor any of its officers, servants or assistants shall, in any way, be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property in connection with or arising from this show. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors or their servants shall indemnify the CWPCA, its officials, servants or assistants against all actions, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. All exhibitors should ensure that they have sufficient third-party liability insurance. Each entry form must be signed as having accepted these conditions. Forms not signed will be returned.
2. The judges' decision will be final. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges should it become necessary.
3. All entries must be registered in or be eligible for registration in their respective stud books.
4. In the event of cancellation, a refund of entries will only be made after the show's expenses have been met.
5. Classes will be held under the showing rules of the relevant societies the show is affiliated to, subject to precedence being taken by any of the show's own regulations. It is expected that exhibitors are aware of the rules of the society that they are members of.
6. All trophies remain the property of CWPCA and must be signed for and returned cleaned 1 month prior to the show.
7. Please do not muck out on to the show field.
8. Please follow parking signs and directions from show officials.
9. Objections must be lodged with the Show Secretary, in writing, within 30 minutes of the end of the class together with £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
10. All horses and ponies must walk in the horse walks and to and from the rings.
11. Assistance from outside the ring could result in the competitor being disqualified from their class.
12. Unacceptable behaviour by competitors/owners will not be tolerated by CWPCA. All competitors/owners/spectators should follow instructions from officials. Unacceptable behaviour could result in being asked to leave the showground and/or having membership revoked.
13. All horses/ponies ridden on show ground must be 4 years old or over.
14. Stallions - riders must have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January of the current year when riding a Section, A, B, C, Welsh Part-bred under 137.2 cm (13.2hh) and their 14th birthday before the 1st of January of the current year for Section D, Welsh Part-bred over 137.2 cm (13.2hh).
15. All exhibits to be up to date with vaccinations and passport must be produced on demand. No admissions without and for rules regarding this please adhere to NPS rules on their website.

Class 2. Welsh Section A or B First Ridden, mares & geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128cms (12.2hh). Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

NPS MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND CLASSES

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS (National Pony Society Rules 2024). Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS Competitions are open to Ponies owned by NPS members and non- members, but only Ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life Members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2024.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

The NPS/Absobine M&M Open in Hand National Championship

Class 12. Small breeds, stallions, mares or geldings any age.

Class 13. Large breeds, stallions, mares or geldings any age.

Championship: 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 12 & 13 to compete.

NPS/Blackertor & Sharptor Studs M&M in Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the qualification. Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or qualification.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home-Produced Ridden Championship Qualifier – Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see Definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in the classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

Class 14. The NPS M&M Novice Leading Rein National Championship, kindly sponsored by The King's Head. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland,

New Forest and Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classics M&M Leading Rein Final before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

Class 15. The NPS M&M/Showing Classics Leading Rein National Championship. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.
NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home-Produced Ridden Championship Qualifier – wear white arm bands

Class 16. The NPS/Bryndefaid Stud M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B, mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Partridge & Parr M&M First Ridden Final before 1st January in current year.

NPS/Fiona Cork Saddles Young Rider Championship Qualifier—rider up to 25 yrs

Class 17. The NPS/Partridge & Parr M&M First Ridden National Championship. Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M Ridden section (excluding Leading Rein, First Ridden) Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or qualification.

NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions.

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or steward. If the owner of the Champion Pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced the Rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the Qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the Final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 6th – 8th August 2024.

SHETLAND PONIES

1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals)
2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc.
3. IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OR OVER MUST HAVE AN "S" NUMBER, AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT OR SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION Ridden stallions MUST display a Stallion Badge. In-hand entire males 2 years and over are encouraged to display a stallion badge.
4. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden ponies must be 4 years old or over. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

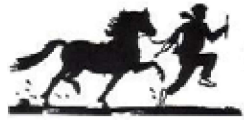
