THE BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY (BSPS) SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW Affiliation Number 467 All Riders competing in BSPS classes must have tagged hats (Rule 43)

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1. (BS) EN1384 2017.ASTM F116304a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards, MUST be worn at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The BSPS. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the BSPS. via the Pony Club Scheme. **Hat tagging in BSPS. classes is compulsory. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags).**

In WHP classes riders must wear body protectors (rule 50).

Body protectors <u>MUST</u> be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including practice ring at BSPS. Affiliated Shows (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all BSPS. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009 (Purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label.

BETA recommends body protectors are replaced every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. **Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form**. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

RIHS Amateur Qualifying Classes 31-34 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class. The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rule 7b in the 2023 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

In **RIHS Qualifying Classes 35-41**, the first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Horse of the Year Show Qualifying Class 8 the first prize winner will qualify, if already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. All Riders, Owners and Producers must be Members of the British Show Horse Association, The Showing Register or Sport Horse Breeding GB. Horses must be registered with the British Show Horse Association, The Showing Register or Sport Horse Breeding GB. The highest placed ungualified exhibit in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2023.

The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2023. The BSHA offer a Novice, Amateur and Young Rider Rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse). The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year. Day Tickets – Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse per Rider per season. At Midland Counties Show a Day Ticket will allow entry into the Open Working Show Horse, Amateur and Novice classes only, but will not allow entry into RIHS & Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form or apply online on the BSHA website. Classes 17, 42-45 will be open to members & non-members of the BSHA.

The two highest placed horses in the top five, not already qualified will qualify for the Final. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members, or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket, Riders 15 years old and over. For full rules and eligibility see BSHA rule book. Fences: min. 2'9, max. 3'0, spread 3'0.

BSHA RISING STAR ASSOCIATE SERIES Open to members and non-members. See BSHA rule book.

BSHA Polly Coles Supreme Qualifier In Hand Horses, Owners and Handlers must be current members of the Association or have Temporary Membership with a Day Ticket. The BSHA offer an Owner/Breeder rosette in each In Hand Breeding class with the exception of the foal class, these have been kindly sponsored by the Kellythorpe Stud. All competitors receiving this award should contact the office to register their interest in the Kellythorpe Stud Owner/Breeder Final at the National Championship Show.

COLOURED HORSE AND PONY SOCIETY (UK)

This show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) Show Affiliation No. 23-120

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid Qualifier card. Members to apply to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 9th-12th August 2023. All Stallions 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS (UK) in order to Compete in these classes and MUST wear their stallion Discs without exception.

Classes 115–118 and 150–156 are CHAPS (UK) qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members Handbook or visit: www.chapsuk.com. for rulings.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW 2023 Qualifiers Classes 153-156

These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, October 2023. Qualification will not pass below 5th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office. This competition is open to mares, gelding and CHAPS (UK) graded stallions, four years old or over, to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of the stud books of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society CHAPS (UK) or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA). All Stallions MUST wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception in order to compete. All Riders and Owners must be members of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society, The Showing Register or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association.

For height restricted exhibits a valid JMB number must be lodged with the respective society. These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show Rule book, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk and competitors must make themselves conversant with these rules before entering these classes. This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. NCPA PONY OF THE YEAR

1st & 2nd prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify for NCPA Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, 3rd September 2023.

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY (NPS)

NPS M&M QUALIFYING ROUNDS To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS Competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but ONLY ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the Final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st-3rd August 2023. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify For the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's membership card to be shown in the ring.

NPS/SHOW PONY & SHOW HUNTER PONY QUALIFYING ROUNDS To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony Studbook sections or the Ridden Register: The GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony Studbook sections or the Ridden Register. Ponies must be plaited. Classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years old and over. Qualifying open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members, but ONLY ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st-3rd August 2023. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's Membership card to be shown in the ring.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life Member** of the NPS.

A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership. card is not immediately produced; the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion pony provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS and has the required membership card in their possession. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home-Produced Ridden Championship

Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in the classes where this is indicated. These ponies if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders in Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by M P GLOSS PRODUCTS UK LTD. The Champion and Reserve from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland In-Hand will qualify for the final to be held at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show on Monday 28th August 2023. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

RoR TATTERSALLS SERIES

Horses must hold a current RoR competition membership.

Tattersalls RoR NOVICE Ridden Show Series (1st,2nd and 3rd placed) to qualify for the final at Aintree August 26th 2023, shows after the 31st July 2023 to qualify for final in 2024. Horses to be ridden by the judge in this class.

Tattersalls RoR Former Racehorse Challenge, all show classes (1st, 2nd and 3rd placed) from 1st August 2022 to 31st July 2023 will be awarded qualification for the championship at The Jockey Club National Show at Aintree on 26th August 2023. Shows after the July 2023 will qualify for the final 2024. The judges will NOT ride in this class. (There will be a reduced number of qualifiers for this class from August 2023)

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series class, all show classes (1st, 2nd and 3rd placed) from 2nd June 2022 to 31st May 2023 will be awarded qualification for the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 25th 2023 Qualifiers held on or after June 3rd 2023 will qualify for the final 2024

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden classes are amateur produced and ridden only. The judges in this class will not ride horses in the qualifiers but the judges will ride in the final.

Tattersalls RoR Open In-Hand Show Series (1st, 2nd and 3rd) to qualify for the final at The Jockey Club National Championships at Aintree August 26th 2023. Shows after 31st July 2023 to qualify for the final in 2024. This is an In-hand class only.

<u>SHB(GB</u>)

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) and who are also registered on the current year's Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter in Qualifying. Classes for Ridden and Working Hunter Championships and the Show Hunter Registration Number must be quoted on all entry forms. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being on the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in any qualifying classes for the remainder of the season.

Competitors may compete on a day ticket and may have a maximum of two day tickets per season. Each day ticket is valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/ over stamp for that show. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/ over stamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Definition: Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

The Society designates certain Shows as qualifying shows for the RIHS at which horses may qualify for the RIHS in the current year or at specific shows for the following year. At these Shows the two highest placed horses in the Lightweight Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there isa Working Hunter Championship made up of the first and second prize winners from the light and heavyweight working hunter classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS unless they have already done so. Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. Judges must place all horses to determine qualifiers.

SHETLAND PONY STUD BOOK SOCIETY

Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show. In order to enter a stallion class at an affiliated show, entire males aged 4 years old must have an "s" number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPS-BS voluntary veterinary examination. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand colts/stallions 2 years and over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a stallion bridle from the SPS-BS.

4) There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years may not show colts (excluding foals) or Entire males in In-Hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In The interests of safety. Hard hats of the current safety standard must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-Hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard Hats must be worn by all exhibitors irrespective of age in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old and over. In ridden Classes if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

This show is affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society Affiliation No AF000036 and offers qualification for **THE NATIONAL WELSH CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW** on the 6th August 2023 at the Three Counties Showground Malvern. Horse walks and pedestrian areas have been clearly laid out by Arena UK and it is imperative that ridden, and in-hand horses and ponies keep within these designated routes when moving around the showground. Pedestrians should keep out of Horse walks and take guidance from Officials or Stewards at crossing points, etc. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to comply with any Health and Safety requirements placed on them whilst competing at the Show and to follow any instructions by stewards or officials. Any exhibitor who fails to comply with health and safety requirements or legislation may be liable to prosecution by HM Health & Safety Executive

19. Conduct of Exhibitors and their Attendants: Any act of discourtesy to any judge, steward, Show Official or Show Organiser on the part of any exhibitor or their attendants, will at the discretion of the injured party, disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited and the exhibitor may be ejected from the Showground.

Competitors are reminded to be courteous to each other. Unsportsmanlike or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated at Midland Counties Show and should be reported immediately to a steward or other official.

Exhibitors shall be responsible for the behaviour of their grooms or assistants or riders and for the consequences of any conduct of such servants or assistants and all persons in charge of exhibits shall be subject to the orders of the index strunged share of the Midland Counties Share Committee

judge, steward, show official or member of the Midland Counties Show Committee.

- 20. In the event of a Veterinary Surgeon advising the removal of any animal from the Show his decision shall be final and immediately complied with.
- 21. Exhibitors are responsible for all costs in connection with any Veterinary Treatment given on the Showground and must be settled at the time with the Veterinary Officer concerned.
- 22. Horses and ponies may be measured at the discretion of the Judge unless in possession of a valid J.M.B. height certificate.

All dogs must be kept on leads and under proper control at all times.
