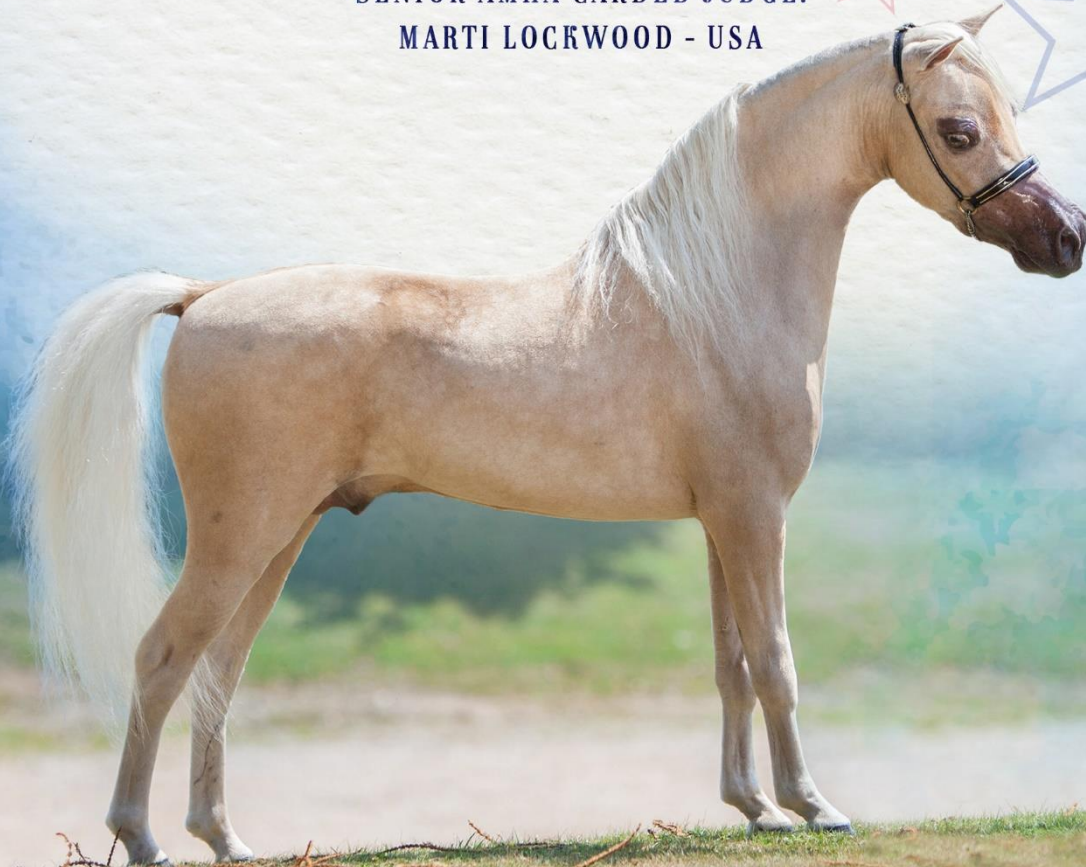

**SHOW RULES**

This show is run under the rules of the MHCGB with the exception of the AMHA classes which will be held strictly under AMHA rules. You can find a full copy at [www.amha.org](http://www.amha.org)

The AMHA section is run strictly under AMHA rules. All exhibitors are therefore asked to acquaint themselves with the current AMHA rule book. The section is open to AMHA members & horses registered with the AMHA only. Please send copy front and back of registration papers with entry.

Senior Stallions require a veterinary certificate stating the horse has two descended testicles.

- The use of 'Pending' on the AMHA entry form will not be accepted, entries will be ignored without exception and not refunded.

**- YOTE – Youth Owned Trained & Exhibited**

Any horse exhibited in YOTE classes must be owned or leased (see lease rules) by the youth individually or jointly, the youth's family. The owner or lessee of record must be so recorded in the AMHA office by January 1st of each year in which the YOTE horse is to be shown. If a horse is acquired after January 1, the youth owner/ lessee must wait until the following year to enter the YOTE classes.

**- AOTE – Amateur Owned Trained & Exhibited**

The horse exhibited by the AOTE must be trained, conditioned, groomed, shown and measured at a show by the AOTE or a non-professional family member in all divisions entered. No one with a professional trainer in the household or on premises may compete in the AOTE division. "Grooming" includes bathing, clipping, razoring and all other allowable enhancements needed to prepare horse for showing. See AMHA rulebook for the full clarification.

**- Amateur**

For horse show purposes, a person is considered an amateur when he or she is no longer eligible to compete in youth classes and has not engaged in any activities, except as a youth, during the past five calendar years which are listed below:

- Having accepted remuneration in the last five years for showing any horse at halter or in performance competition, training, schooling either horses or other persons
- Having accepted remuneration in the last five years for having conducted seminars, clinics, given instruction in showing, training, or judging.
- Having accepted remuneration in the last five years for judging or being a horse breed association judge or horse show association judge
- An individual who has had entry fees paid or has received premium money would still be considered an amateur

**- Stock Division**

A horse may not show in more than one halter division at any show with the exception of color and/or Special Needs classes. Stock horses should wear stock type/western show halters.

- **Rules on age**

Driving horses 3 years plus. Jumping horses 3 years plus. Liberty 2 years plus. Halter obstacle 2 years plus.

- The organisers shall not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by any exhibitor.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes if there are insufficient entries. With the exception of AMHA classes.
- Classes with sufficient entries may be split at the discretion of the show manager.
- All exhibitors and handlers must be current members of MHCGB by close of entries with the exception of AMHA classes.
- Any complaints/protests must be made in writing accompanied by a £50 deposit to the Show Manager within 1 hour of the alleged incident. Deposit will be refunded if the complaint is substantiated.

- **Conduct**

Cruelty, abuse, or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, or stalls, or on the showground is strictly prohibited. MHCGB code of conduct of its members should be always adhered to at all times.

- **Responsibility**

MHCGB and show management cannot be held responsible for any accidents, damages, or loss to personal property or livestock.

- **House Keeping**

We kindly ask you to respect the venue and the staff.

Dispose of any rubbish carefully, and **do not** muck out lorries in the car parks or onto the field, please use the muck heap provided.

Strictly no hay, feed, grass or use of hoof blacking or chalk in the indoor arena or in stable barns. Please bring carpet to stand your horse on.

**Stables:** Stables are to be inspected upon arrival before putting your horse in.

Stables are to be thoroughly cleaned out upon leaving. No exceptions.

Its advisable that you leave a contact number and name on your stable in case of an emergency.

The indoor barn is for sponsors use only, the wash racks and solarium are not to be used by anyone other than sponsors!

**Dogs:**

Dogs are welcome and must be kept on a lead at all times.

They are not allowed on the decking outside the cafe or In the Cafe. Please bring your poo bags!

All vehicles must be parked on the field.

Hook ups are to be paid for and on a first come first serve basis. Please do not park in front of a hook up if you do not intend to use it.

**Entry Fees**

All entry fees are non returnable.
