CLASS 21: Unclipped Mares, Fillies and Geldings

CLASS 22: Category A Unclipped - Open To All Miniature horses not exceeding 34" at maturity

CLASS 23: Category B Unclipped - Open To All Miniature Horses Exceeding 34" up to 38" at maturity

THE SEBSONS UNCLIPPED CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st and 2nd Prize Winners from Classes 18 – 23

RESTRICTED SECTION

The Restricted section classes 24 - 27 are strictly only open to horses nor handlers that have never won an overall Supreme or a Reserve overall Supreme at any show or qualified for HOYS.

CLASS 24: Restricted Youngstock Class – Open to yearlings and 2 year olds not exceeding 38" at maturity.

CLASS 25: Restricted 3 Years Old And Over Class - Not exceeding 38" at maturity.

CLASS 26: Restricted Broken Coloured /Spotted Class – Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity.

CLASS 27: Restricted Solid Colour / Any Other Colour Class – Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity.

CLASS 28: Broken colour class - Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity
CLASS 29: Spotted Class - Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity
CLASS 30: Solid Colour Class - Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity
CLASS 31: Any Other Colour Class - Any age not exceeding 38" at maturity



ALL CLASSES TO BE JUDGED MHCGB STYLE MHCGB SHOWING STYLE

Horses are to enter the ring, individually in catalogue order, at a walk clockwise on a loose lead to a designated point marked by a cone approximately 20 feet from the gate and then proceed at a trot past the judge/s. Judging will begin at the cone.

Line up horses head to tail along the ringside, teeth and testicles are checked for correctness. The judge then re takes his/her position in the centre of the ring. From line-up, competitors walk to judge and trot past, back to the end of line, to assess straightness of movement.

Horse are then posed nose to tail approx. 15 feet from the edge of the ring and with sufficient distance between to allow judges to assess horses from all sides. Horses are assessed individually in the nose to tail line up. (See diagram). The final line up is then called in and Rosettes are awarded.



COLOUR CLASSES

Colour Classes are judged on 80% colour, 20% conformation. Horses are walked into the arena and then asked to turn and walk in the opposite direction. Horses are then lined nose to tail in rows, allowing space for the judge to pass between each horse to assess. The horses are trotted at the discretion of the judge.

CATEGORY A

No miniature horse shall exceed 34 inches in height Weanlings must not exceed 30 inches Yearlings must not exceed 32 inches Two year olds must not exceed 33 inches Three year olds and over must not exceed 34 inches CATEGORY B

Miniature horses exceeding 34 inches but no taller then 38 inches at maturity Weanlings exceeding 30 inches and must not exceed 34 inches Yearlings exceeding 32 inches and must not exceed 36 inches Two year olds exceeding 33 inches and must not exceed 37 inches Three year olds and over exceeding 34 inches must not exceed 38 inches

EXCLUSIVE


Open to horses and ASPC'S exceeding 38 inches and no taller 46 inches at maturity

Weanlings exceeding 34 inches and no taller then 42 inches Yearlings exceeding 36 inches and no taller then 44 inches Two year olds exceeding 37 inches and no taller then 45 inches

- ENTRIES: All entries will be taken by MHCGB and accepted strictly under MHCGB rules.
- 2) HEIGHT: Please enter your horses in the correct classes for their heights. Please refer to the Official Rule Book Of The Miniature Horse Club Of Great Britain <u>www.mhcgb.co.uk/mhcgb-rule-book.html</u> HORSES WILL BE SUBJECT TO MEASUREMENT IF ANY COMPLAINTS ARE RECEIVED.
- 3) EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS: All horses attending The show must have received two primary EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart. If sufficient time has elapsed a booster vaccination must have been received not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the second primary vaccination. Further booster vaccinations must have been given annually at intervals of not more than 12 months apart. No vaccinations must have been given within the preceding 7 days including the day of the show.
- 4) **INSURANCE**: It is recommended that all horses are insured. Horses that do not have any insurance can attend the show at the horse owners own risk.

- ANIMAL WELFARE: All exhibitors to observe the best practice at all times. No cruelty to any animals will be tolerated any offending party will be made to leave the showground.
- 6) ACCIDENTS: The show, Venue, MHCGB and all organizers will not be responsible in any way for any loss, damage, illness, accident, Injury etc. sustained by or to any exhibitor, person or animal. Persons with Parental Responsibility are responsible for the safety and welfare of children attending this event. It is a condition of entry that the exhibitor shall hold the Show, Venue, MHCGB and all organisers harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident, loss, damage, illness or injury etc.
- 7) Any animal showing any sign of disease or illness will be requested to leave the showground.
- 8) Entries are non refundable.
- 9) **STALLIONS AND COLTS:** Stallions and colts must only be handled by an attendant of 12 years of age or older.
- Access to the Showground Exhibitors are asked to follow the directions to the Showground and to allow adequate time for entry to the Show site, parking and unloading of their entries.
- 11) **AMHA/AMHR/ASPC REGISTERD CLASSES**: All AMHA/AMHR/ASPC entries must be accompanied by copies of the entered horses AMHA/AMHR/ASPC Papers.
- 12) **DRIVING**: All driving entries must be insured.


