# Show Rules

**Abusive language or behaviour toward show officials, helpers, fellow competitors or animals will NOT be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the show ground.**

1. This show is not open to the public and operates under the NCPA Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy and Animal Welfare Code of Practise
2. All persons entering the showground must have personal and public liability insurance. The committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any person, animal or property whilst on the showground. Under NO circumstances must anyone other than the judge, stewards, competitors or grooms enter the show rings.
3. In the interest of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring, will NOT be tolerated.
4. The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing, within one hour of the end of the class/incident and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £30.00. In the event of the objection being upheld, the deposit will be returned in full.
5. The committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes, as the entries warrant.
6. The committee reserve the right to cancel or refuse any entry made.
7. Under no circumstances will/can entries be substituted and any refunds will be at the discretion of the committee and subject to a £10.00 admin charge.
8. In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date, unconditionally.
9. In the event of cancellation refunds MUST be requested in writing and should be sent with an SAE enclosed to the show secretary within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £5.00 admin charge.
10. M&M ponies to be shown in accordance with the Breed Society rules.
11. Stallions may NOT be led or ridden by children under the age of 14.
12. The committee reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
13. Dishonoured cheques will incur a £10.00 admin fee and may result in the refusal of future entries.
14. All grooms entering the ring must wear a hat and be of smart appearance.
15. All riding hats MUST adhere to current UK standards.

Stallion, Mare or Gelding, to be registered in the pure-bred section of the relevant breed society. Riders any age, except for riders of stallions. Riders of stallions 138cms & under must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> Jan in the current year and riders of stallions exceeding 138cms must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan in the current year.

### **Class 2 - NCPA Registered Non M&M Ridden**

Stallion, Mare or Gelding, rider any age & to be a suitable size for the animal they ride.

**CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners from the NCPA Registered classes**

### **NPS M&M Lead Rein & First Ridden Winter Qualifiers**

#### **Class 3 - The NPS/Williams & Nash Novice M&M Lead Rein Winter Championship Qualifier**

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B Mares and Geldings 4 years old or over not exceeding 122 cm and not to have won a first prize in any Lead Rein class Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

#### **Class 4 - The NPS/ Area 25 Novice M&M First Ridden Winter Championship /P(UK) M&M First Ridden Qualifier**

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B Mares and Geldings 4 years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. and not to have won a first prize in any First Ridden class. Riders no to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

*Ponies must NOT be cantered except in their individual show*

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP: Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners from the Novice LR/FR classes**

### **NPS M&M Lead Rein & First Ridden Winter Qualifiers**

#### **Class 5 - The NPS Open M&M Lead Rein Winter Championship Qualifier**

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B Mares and Geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

#### **Class 6 - The NPS Open M&M First Ridden Winter Championship Qualifier**

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B Mares and Geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP : Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize winners from the Open LR/FR classes**

Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book, Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Sections C & D. **Ponies not to have been placed first in any Ridden M&M class (excluding Leading Rein or First Ridden)** Rider any age, except stallions (see NPS rules) All ponies in this class MUST be shown in a snaffle bit.
