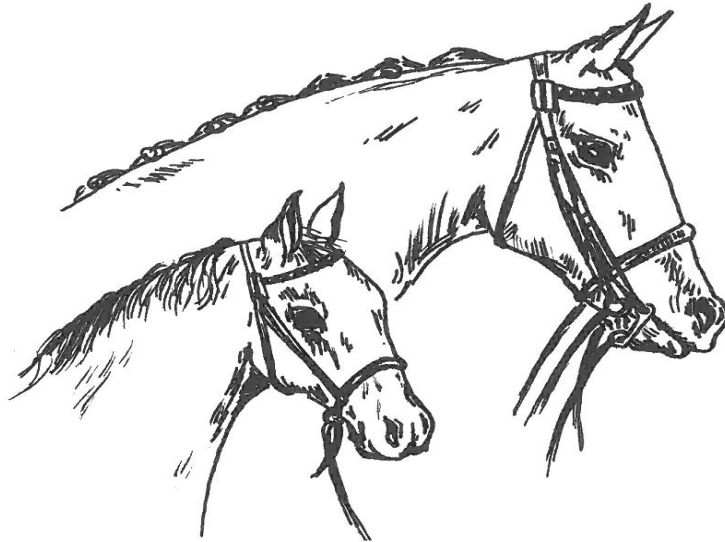

## **PRIZE MONEY**

1<sup>st</sup> = £25, 2<sup>nd</sup> = £15, 3<sup>rd</sup> = £5 will be awarded in classes 2 – 7, 18 – 21 and 33 – 36.

Class 10 RoR Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> £20, 3<sup>rd</sup> £10.

Other classes only 1<sup>st</sup> prize money will be awarded if less than 6 entries in each class.

## **ROSETTES, QUALIFICATION CARDS & TROPHIES**

Rosettes will be awarded to 4<sup>th</sup> place in every class.

It is the Competitor's responsibility to ensure that they have received the appropriate qualification card before they leave the showground. In classes where membership or qualification cards need to be produced, it is the competitor's responsibility to sure that they have cards with the in the ring. Failure to produce these cards may result in no entry to the class, disqualification or non-award of qualification.

All trophies are held for a year and must be returned to the Secretary by 1<sup>st</sup> February in the following year it was presented. Trophies can be collected from the Secretary, on the day, by presenting their Trophy Card, which will have been given to the winner by the judge. All trophies must be signed for by a responsible adult who will additionally be responsible for its safe return. A copy of theirs and the winner's details will retained by the Secretary.

# **RULES, CONDITIONS AND BY LAWS**

- Hats with chin straps must be fastened at all times when mounted. All affiliated classes have their own hat rule and these will be enforced.- NOTE All Young Handlers **MUST** wear a Compliant Hard Hat **for BSPS classes competitors are required to comply with rule 43 in the 2023 BSPS handbook.**
- **All exhibitors must have third party liability insurance.**
- All competitors in the unaffiliated ridden classes and junior handlers must wear a hat which meets the current Safety Standards.
- Horses and ponies not entered in a class must not be brought to the show. This is to ensure that all animals attending have their passports and vaccinations checked.
- It is expected that all competitors working in wear their back numbers.
- Only tack that is permitted in the ring is allowed whilst competitors are mounted on the showground
- **Under no circumstances** must horses and ponies be tied up to horse boxes or trailers and left unattended **for any length of time.**
- The Judge's decision is final
- Any person found displaying abusive behaviour towards judges, stewards and other officials will be disqualified from competing and asked to leave the showground.
- The committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground.
- The Committee reserves the right to amend the schedule and refuse entries at their discretion.
- Objections must be logged in writing within 30 minutes of the event with the deposit of £50, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Whilst every effort will be made to avoid the clashing of classes, no refund of entry fees will be made in the event of this happening.
- No mucking out of horse boxes must be done on the showground. Anyone found doing so will be asked to leave the showground and could be fined £50.
- Please ensure that you take your litter home or deposit it in the bins provided.
- Dogs **must be kept on a lead at all times & any mess cleaned up**

## **BSPS**

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This show is affiliated to the BSPS and all classes are held in accordance with the 2023 Rule & Show Handbook and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS Rules will be liable to dope testing.

**Hats: for BSPS classes competitors are required to comply with rule 43 in the 2023 BSPS handbook.**

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Championships 2023 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prizewinners will qualify in classes 38 - 42 and 48 and 51. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> prizewinners in classes 43 - 45 provided the animal is owned, registered and ridden by a BSPS member or in accordance with the BSPS rules 21 & 26.

### **BSPS Challenge and 2023 Horse of the Year Show**

Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, Open Lead Rein of Show Hunter type, SHP, Int SRT 7SH, Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden & Ridden. This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2023 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class.

1<sup>st</sup> prize winners in the BSPS open classes will qualify for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions.

This is qualifier for the **BSPS Area 2B Points**

## **NCPA**

This show is a qualifier for the Junior Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year.

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show in September 2023 at Warren Farm. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> prizewinners will qualify. **NCPA Star Rosettes\*** will be awarded in classes 8,18, 36 & 42 Members must enter the ring wearing their NCPA badge and be in possession of the CURRENT year's membership card. **NCPA registered pony rosettes+** will be awarded to the highest placed NCPA registered Horse or Pony in classes 53, 62 & 64 Handlers must wear a red armband and their pink card must be produced in the ring. It is a condition of entry that the horse/pony registration number is quoted on the entry form. All appropriate classes qualify for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show.

## **UK PONIES & HORSES LIMITED**

This show is a qualifier for the UK Ponies & Horses Summer Classic.\* 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> placed combinations in Classes 33 – 36 will qualify. Qualification cards are NOT distributed in the ring, however results can be verified by the office. Competitors are not required to become a member of UK Ponies & Horses to compete at the Summer Classic

**The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first 5 will qualify for UK Ponies & Horses RIHS Mountain & Moorland Ridden Final 2023 and RIHS Amateur Riders Mountain & Moorland Final 2023 to be held at RIHS, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU in July 2023. To be judged in accordance with the Rules of UK H&P Ltd. Qualifications will be verified by the office.**

# RING 1

## Commences: 8.00 am

### RIHS RIDDEN HUNTER CLASSES

**It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured skull caps/riding hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards**

**AII PASS 015, VG1; ASTM F1163a onwards; SNEL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards**

**Judges: Ride: Ms Vikki Smith**

**Conformation: Nigel Hollings**

This show is affiliated to the SHB(GB) and is subject to its rules, copies of which can be obtained. All hunter classes will be judged under the Society's rules and the SHB(GB) requires all exhibits in these classes to be registered with the Society. Classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 are qualifying events for this year's RIHS and only horses registered to the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. The Show Hunter Registration number must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society.

**Day Ticket = £36** (This entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owners and rider membership, together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. Contact SHB(GB) for more information. Any horse that is entered in any qualifying class without first being on the Show Hunter register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will NOT be eligible for entry in any qualifying classes for the remainder of the season. The 2 highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter the RIHS. No lower than 2<sup>nd</sup> place will qualify.

Classes 6 & 7 - In the lightweight section, the 2 highest placed smalls and the 2 highest placed lightweights will qualify. In the heavyweight section, the 2 highest placed middleweights and the 2 highest placed heavyweights will qualify. Judges must place all horses to determine qualifiers.

Owners, riders and producers of horses competing in **any Ridden Hunter or Ridden Sports Horse classes**, run in accordance with these rules, must be Members of the Society

- 1 **Novice Ridden Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 & 5 year old, not having won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize value of £60 or a total of £200 (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated ridden hunter classes at home or abroad before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019, excepting all prize money awarded in 4 year old classes only. This does not apply to Novice Working Hunter Classes. Any horse that qualifies for HOYS in a Ridden Hunter Class (not including WH Classes) will not be eligible to compete in Novice Classes from 1<sup>st</sup> January the following year, but horses that qualified as a 4 year old are exempt
- 2 **RIHS Lightweight Ridden Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 year old and over. Horses to exceed 153cm and be capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs). Rider to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- 3 **RIHS Middleweight Ridden Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Horses to exceed 153cm and be capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs) not exceeding 89kgs (14 stone). Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- 4 **RIHS Heavyweight Ridden Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Horses to exceed 153cm and be capable of carrying over 89kgs (14 stone). Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year.
- 5 **RIHS Small Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Horses to exceed 148cm and not to exceed 158cm. Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**\*RIHS Ridden Hunter Championship: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 2 – 5 to compete**

### RIHS AMATEUR CLASSES

#### **AMATEUR RULES AND DEFINITION**

It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules, The Directors/Board/Council reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary.

**OWNERSHIP:** All owners should be registered in the passport as per the latest DEFRA regulations.

**PROFESSIONAL PRODUCER/TRAINER/RIDER:** A person who undertakes the preparation/training/keeping at livery, production of equines/riders or competes as a Rider or jobbing Rider.

**PROFESSIONAL GROOM:** A person who is employed full, part-time or is self-employed and receives remuneration, monetary or otherwise, for the preparation/training/keeping or production of equines.

No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during Amateur classes, this applies to equines, riders and any attendees.

A **PROFESSIONAL SHOWING STATUS:** anyone who has operated as a Professional Showing Producer, Rider or Groom will, for the purposes of these Rules, always be deemed a professional; including when acting as a Groom.

- B AMATEUR STATUS: - a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under SHB(GB) Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:
- a) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, as a means of deriving a source of income.
  - b) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stables or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
  - c) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
  - d) Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes SHB(GB) or otherwise, or a horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an exhibit, which has been ridden by a professional rider in any open classes, SHB(GB) or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working classes and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the RIHS.  
(The above Rule does not apply, if the horse has been professionally produced and ONLY ridden by the professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new ownership).
  - e) If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board/Council, ie, if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed a professional.

- 6 **RIHS Amateur Lightweight Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over. Horses to exceed 153cm and be capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs) Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. (Small Hunters to be included in this Lightweight).
- 7 **RIHS Amateur Heavyweight Hunter:** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Horses to exceed 153cm and be capable carrying up to 89kgs (14 stone) Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. (Middleweight and Heavyweight Hunters to be included in this section).

**\*RIHS Amateur Ridden Hunter Championship: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 6 & 7 to compete**

### ROR CLASSES

**To follow RIHS Hunter classes – Not before 11.00 am**

**Judge: David Bennett**

- 8\* **Unaffiliated Open Ridden Show Class for Former Racehorses:**  
Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023  
Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband.  
Horses should be plaited.  
All entries **MUST** be competition registered with the RoR and have **RACED in GB. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.**  
**Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series**
- 9 **Unaffiliated OPEN In Hand Show Class for Former Racehorses:**  
Open to all RoR and NR **competition registered** horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings.  
Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a Bitless/In Hand Bridle.  
Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.  
**Handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.**
- 10 **Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2023:**  
Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double

bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited.  
The Series is open to **AMATEURS** only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete.  
Class will be judged under ‘riding horse’ format without ‘type’ being taken into consideration.  
Racing injuries and blemishes **ARE IGNORED** in this series  
The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the final.  
Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.  
**The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting 25<sup>th</sup> June 2023**  
**RoR Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup>**

**Amateur definition:**

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:  
Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.  
Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2022  
Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.  
Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season.  
A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show.

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

**\*Championship: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 8 - 10 to compete**

**OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES**

**Classes 11 – 17 will Follow on from ROR Classes - will not be ridden by the judge**

- 11 Open Ridden Hunter:** Exceeding 153cm. 4 years old and over.
- 12 Open Ridden Cob:** Exceeding 148cm. 4 years old and over.
- 13 Open Ridden Show Hack:** Exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 160cm. 4 years old and over.
- 14 Open Ridden Riding Horse:** Exceeding 148cm. 4 years old and over.
- 15 Open Ridden Coloured:** Horses and ponies any height. 4 years old and over, any type (Plaited, Traditional, Cob, Native)
- 16 Open Ridden Arab, Pure/Part Bred/Anglo:** Horses and Ponies any height. 4 years old and over.
- 17 Open Ridden Traditional Gypsy Cob, Solid and Coloured:** Horses and Ponies any height. 4 years old and over.

**\*Open Ridden Championship: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 11-17 to compete**

**RIHS BSPA RIDDEN COLOURED CLASSES**

**Not Before 2PM**

These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from [www.bsponline.com](http://www.bsponline.com) all horses and ponies must be registered and all owners and riders must be BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age are taken from 1<sup>st</sup> January. Membership and qualification cards **must** be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or and under must possess a current JMB height certificate (Shetlands exempt).

Competitors qualifying at this show the The Royal International Horse Show July 2022 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48 hours of qualifying to The Show Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA for 2022 and have BSPA stallion ID card and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2022 membership if the BSPA, and a RIHS qualification card. **Memberships/horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes.**

Qualification: 1<sup>st</sup> place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place. BSPA Office: 01354 638226; email: [bspashows@gmail.com](mailto:bspashows@gmail.com). Skewbald and Piebald horses and ponies only. Highest placed Amateur and highest placed Junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championships Final to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show September 2022. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.

**All horses/ponies must be registered with BSPA all owners/riders members of BSPA prior to entry and membership & qualification cards must be carried into the ring and signed at the time of qualification in the ring by the Judge. Failure to comply with this rule will mean disqualification.**
