This competition assesses the potential for a pony to be a competitive eventing pony either currently or in the future.

Open to mares, geldings and stallions four year old and over, maximum height 158cm, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Ponies' manes may be plaited at competitor discretion. Ponies may be measured at the judge's discretion. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

The NPS strongly recommends body protectors are worn in all NPS jumping competitions especially over fixed obstacles.

Rules and Condition of Entry

- 1. This show is run under the National Pony Society's 2022 Rules, copies of which can be obtained from The Secretary, National Pony Society, Arthur Rank Centre, Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire, CV8 2LG
- 2. NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship Conditions: To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the Champion pony is a Qualifying or Life Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and must be produced immediately on request by either the Judge or Steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the Final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 2022.
- 3. All ponies in Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and conform to the height limits laid down by their Breed Societies. There is no height limit for Dales or Welsh Cobs, Section D.
- 4. Broodmares must be four years old or over and must be shown in the ring with own foal at foot. All foals must be at least four weeks old on the day of the show. A barren mare is a mare without a foal at foot in the current season. Mares with live foals born in the current year cannot be entered in Riding, Driving or WHP classes.
- 5. All stallions and colts, 2 years old or over, must be in possession of a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 6. Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle disc. In Hand stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be adequately bitted and may display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other society.
- 7. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Riders of M&M stallions small breeds or stallions not exceeding 138 cm must have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of large M&M stallion or those exceeding 138 cm must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 8. In all classes whips / canes must not exceed 75 cm.(30").
- 9. Lunging is only allowed in the designated area of the Showground.
- 10. The decision of the Judge is final. Any objection must be handed in to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit.
- 11. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or sub-divide any class as may seem justified.
- 12. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without assigning a reason.
- 13. The class is closed and ponies will not be allowed into the ring: In-hand - when the last pony has done its individual trot around the ring before being lined up Ridden - when the class goes into trot WHP - 5 minutes after the last pony has jumped.
 14. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.
- 15. Ponies are not to be left unattended whilst tied to the outside of vehicles/trailers.
- 16. No entry fees will be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is presented.
- 17. Neither the Committee nor the Landowner will be held responsible for any accident or damage to persons, animals or property on the showground.
- 18. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
- 19. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 20. Please do not leave any litter by the ringside or your transport but place it in the receptacles provided.
- 21. We strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
- 22. In the event of cancellation, a proportion of entry fees may be withheld.
- 23. No person shall ill-treat animals at any time (see NPS Rule Book page 3)
- 24. No Member or Non-Member shall behave in an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at the show (see NPS Rule Book page 3)
- 25. The Show Secretary/NPS Wessex Area 24 Committee shall have the right to alter classes on the day should circumstances warrant it. Their decision is FINAL.
