- 2. A pony shall not be deemed to be a Novice if by 1st January of the current year it has:- won an open NPS Affiliated Ridden Mountain & Moorland class, won a class at an Olympia/Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Qualifying round, Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS

Qualified for the Novice/Intermediate Ridden Mountain & Moorland Final at Malvern, Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship at Olympia in previous years or the current year

- 3. All ponies in Novice classes must be shown in a snaffle bridle
- 4. Silver Medal Qualification: The pony is to be owned by the exhibitor, who must be a full life or qualifying NPS member and carry their current membership card in the ring.
- 5. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries at closing date, sub-divide any class or withdraw any prize money. 6. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries without giving a reason
- 7. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 8. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.

All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. The EN1384, BSEN1384 may also be worn until 1st January 2017, unless otherwise notified. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets one of the above standards. 19. No loose dogs allowed on the showground.
- 20. In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.
- 21. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".
