Caledonian Showing Championships



This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of.

This year's show will be held at Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 18/19/20 October 2024

Every horse & pony placed 1st or 2nd in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. In addition all placed 3rd in Royal International & Royal London classes will qualify. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website <u>www.caledonianchampionships.co.uk</u> (under construction) or the Puddledub Shows Facebook page

STARS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SHOW



We are delighted that the Puddledub Winter (from March), Spring, Summer & Sunday Funday Shows all Carry qualification for this fabulous show at Aintree in November.

Qualification would be from the highest points winner from each of 42 Categories (assuming there are no Changes from Class Classifications from last year).

All the classes at this show that will gain points towards qualification have the STARS logo next to the class number. Please realise that where points are allocated in classes such as Novice, those totals will be separate to the same class category in Open etc

In the case of equal points, the decision as to which horse/pony will represent Puddledub Shows will be at the discretion of the organisers/committee

Abbreviated STARS 2024 Rules

Rule 1a	Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to your champion, reserve champion and 2nd res champion. Each club MUST offer the option of representing their club to each class champion. Should they be unable to attend you may pass down to res champion and 2 nd res. Each club is allowed to send 1 competitor for each class. If you have 2 competitors with equal marks, then both can enter IF we have capacity, please check with STARS. If we can't accommodate both entries it will be determined by the competitor that attended the most points shows if they both attended the same amount, then send the one that won the most first places.
1b	Show dates must run between March and September 2024.
1c	No points show can be held after 17 th September 2024 Entries for STARS will open on 18 th September and close on October 2 nd , 2024.
1d Rule 2a	All RC's must hold a minimum of 4 points shows in 2024. j
2b	All competitors must attend a minimum of 2 points shows.
	In addition to the above rules, we have noticed that many RC's run a non-points trophy show mid-season, can we ask if possible that your trophy shows be held in September so that all show secretaries have plenty of time to invite their competitors to represent them at STARS, this also enables each competitor to know if they have qualified when entries and stabling opens on September 18 th .
Rule 3	Any competitor may compete in more than 1 class at STARS providing they meet the criteria for each class. Each competitor can represent as many RC's as they want.
Rule 4	Competitors must be current members of each club/club they represent.
Rule 5a	It is a condition of affiliation that all RC secretaries keep records of their points for each class and a running points total sheet must be available at each show or online throughout the season, for competitors and STARS admin. At STARS final these sheets need to be always available.
Rule 6	No change of combination of horse/pony/rider is permitted from that which qualified through their club. The leader of a LR pony may be substituted under exceptional circumstances arise with permission from STARS.
Rule 7a	No horse or pony can compete at STARS if they have qualified HOYS in any class including search for a star in 2024 or 2023.
	Horses and ponies that qualified HOYS in 2022 are eligible provided they were not placed. Search For a Star placings are allowed
Rule 7b Rule 8	Riders/handlers cannot have ridden/led any animal at HOYS in 2024, riding /leading any other year is permitted. No horse or pony that has been placed in the top 5 at the RIHS in current year can compete at STARS. Riders can compete on a different horse or pony.
Rule 9a	No professional producers can compete at STARS, or any horse or pony that is in, or has been in production from March 1 st , 2024. The definition of a professional producer is as follows: The horse or pony is kept at a producer's yard on show production or for any other reason including being broken, holiday livery ect. The horse or pony is prepared for a show, bathed plaited etc, horse or pony has been taken to a show. Horse or pony has been worked in or tuition given to owner / rider at a show. Horse or pony stripped, or assistance given in the ring. If any of the above apply to your horse, then they are not eligible to come to STARS.

We do allow full livery on a professional yard provided it is NOT a showing yard. We understand some people work long hours need full livery inc exercise, however no-show production of any kind is allowed.

- Rule 9b Semi Professionals, any competitor that shows 2 or more animals for other people regardless of if you take payment for your services or not, we class you as a semi-professional. Semi-professionals are not eligible to compete at STARS. We do not mind how many horses or ponies you show if they belong to you, and we do not want to stop friends from helping each other but it cannot be more than 1 friend.
 - 9c No competitor can have shown a horse or pony that belongs or is produced by a professional producer at any show in 2024.

STARS was created for the home produced, amateurs and true grassroot competitors. We ask people to take this rule in the spirit intended and we will disqualify anyone who we feel is bending the rules. If we feel any situation is a grey area and not fully covered by our rules, then each case will be determined by STARS and our decision will be final.

- Rule 11 Social media rules: You must not post or transmit any material which could dame the name or reputation of STARS or its competitors/organisers. Any person found guilty of this would constitute a breach of STARS rules and could result in civil/criminal proceedings being brought against you.
- Rule 12 Any stallions must be ridden / handled by a competent person with a minimum age of 14.

MINI WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

- Class 1a **INHAND WORKERS,** any age, any height. Maximum height of fences 35cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers.
- Class 1b LEAD REIN/ASSISTED WHP, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. No age limit for riders. This class is intended for novice/nervous riders not confident to attempt a course on their own. Maximum height of fences 35cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers. Lead rein ponies not exceeding 128cm and riders not to have attained their 10th birthday are eligible for STARS points
- Class 2 **TINY TOTS WHP**, mares or geldings , 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday. Maximum height of jumps 40cm
- Class 3 **PLAITED NURSERY STAKES PONY,** mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders to be a suitable height and size for their pony. Maximum height of jumps 50cm
- Class 4 M&M NURSERY STAKES PONY, Registered Pure-Bred Ponies mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders to be a suitable height and size for their pony. Maximum height of jumps 45cm

"PLAITED" & "NON M&M" WORKING HUNTER PONY

For plaited (or hogged) or "hairy" non/unregistered M&M mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms (approx. 15hh). RIDERS ANY AGE. There will be NO combination fences to ensure there is no issue over striding with a variety of pony heights in each class. Entries can be made in as many classes/heights as wished.



Ponies need to be plaited (running plait acceptable) or hogged at STARS. STARS points will be allocated as follows: Classes 7a, 8a, 9a & 10a for ponies not exceeding 133cm, Classes 8a, 9a &10a for ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 153cm

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONY

For Registered pure-bred stallions, mares or geldings. RIDERS ANY AGE. There will be NO combination fences to ensure there is no issue over striding with a variety of pony heights in each class. Entries can be made in as many classes/heights as wished.



STARS points will be allocated as follows: Classes 7b, 8b, 9b & 10b for ponies not exceeding 133cm, Classes 8b, 9b & 10b for ponies exceeding 133cm

- PONIES IN THE a & b CLASSES CAN JUMP IN ANY ORDER AS A MIXED CLASS BUT ROSETTES AND PLACINGS WILL BE MADE AS TWO CLASSES
- Class 5a **30cm "PLAITED" or "NON M&M" WHP,** simple fences of straight bar or cross poles, no fillers
- Class 5b **30cm MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WHP,** simple fences of straight bar or cross poles, no fillers
- Class 6a **45cm "PLAITED" or "NON M&M" WHP,** simple fences with a few fillers, nothing too scarey
- Class 6b **45cm MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WHP,** simple fences with a few fillers, nothing too scarey
- Class 7a 60cm "PLAITED" or "NON M&M" WHP, few more fillers
- Class 7b 60cm MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WHP, few more fillers
- Class 8a 75cm "PLAITED" or "NON M&M" WHP, more fillers and a few more questions
- Class 8b 75cm MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WHP, more fillers and a few more questions
- Class 9a **90cm "PLAITED" or "NON M&M" WHP**, a bit more of a challenge, but remains inviting

HORSE WORKER CLASSES

Open to all types of horses, not just 'hunter' types, and may compete in as many height classes as wished. Riders may also ride more than one horse in each class

- Class 11 HORSE WORKER 40cm, mares, geldings or stallions, any breed or type, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms.
- Class 12 HORSE WORKER 60cm, mares, geldings or stallions, any breed or type, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms.
- Class 13 HORSE WORKER 80cm, mares, geldings or stallions, any breed or type, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms.
- Class 14 HORSE WORKER 100cm, mares, geldings or stallions, any breed or type, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms.
- Class 15 HORSE WORKER 110cm, mares, geldings or stallions, any breed or type, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms.

- Class 17 **BEST TURNED OUT INHAND HORSE.** Horses exceeding 153cm/15hh of all breeds, ages and types. Handlers any age. Will be judged on correctness of turnout for type, so plaited and unplaited are equally eligible.
- Class 18 **BEST TURNED OUT RIDDEN PONY.** Ponies not exceeding 153cm/15hh of all breeds, ages and types. Riders any age. Will be judged on correctness of turnout for type, so plaited and unplaited are equally eligible. No individual shows, brief walk round and then line up.
- Class 19 **BEST TURNED OUT RIDDEN HORSE.** Horses exceeding 153cm/15hh of all breeds, ages and types. Riders any age. Will be judged on correctness of turnout for type, so plaited and unplaited are equally eligible. No individual shows, brief walk round and then line up.

BEST TURNOUT CHAMPIONSHIP open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 16 to 19

INHAND PONIES

- Class 20 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND YOUNGSTOCK. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 1, 2 or 3 years old. Class will be split by age or small/large breeds if there are sufficient entries.
- Class 21 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND ADULT INHAND. Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Class will be split by small/large breeds if there are sufficient entries.
- Class 22 **"PLAITED" & "UNPLAITED" PONY INHAND. Show Pony, SHP, Cob etc. (excl M&Ms)** Any Age. Not exceeding 153cm/15hh. Class will be split by age, height or type if there are sufficient entries. *STARS points to plaited not exc 148cm and Hogged or "Hairy" Cobs*
- Class 23 COLOURED, PALOMINO, TWO TONE INHAND, to be shown plaited, natural or hogged. Any Age, Not exceeding 153cm/15hh. Coloureds only eligible for STARS points
- Class 24 **VETERAN INHAND,** 15 years old & over. Not exceeding 153cm/15hh. Any type, to be judged on conformation, movement, condition and soundness

INHAND PONY CHAMPIONSHIP open to 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 20 to 24

MINI PONIES

- Class 25 LEAD REIN, 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to any type of pony; Show Pony, SHP, M&M, Coloured etc. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. Snaffle bridles only. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband and the leader's hand only *Rosettes to all entries*.
- Class 26 **FIRST RIDDEN**, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to any type of pony; Show Pony, SHP, M&M, Coloured etc. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries.

- Class 27 TINY TOTS HANDLER, (supervision permitted) Handlers not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st January in the current year.. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account.
- YOUNG HANDLER, Handlers to have attained their 7th birthday but not attained their Class 28 10th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account.
- JUNIOR HANDLER Handlers to have attained their 10th birthday but not attained Class 29 their 18th birthday by 1st January in the current year.. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account.
- Class 30 ADULT HANDLER, Handlers to have been 18 years or older at 1st January in the current year. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account.

INHAND HORSES

- HORSE YOUNGSTOCK. Hunter, Hack, Cob, Riding Horse, Warmblood/Sport Horse, Class 31 Coloured, Arab, Heavy Horse etc 1, 2 or 3 years old. Class will be split by age or type if there are sufficient entries.
- Class 32 "PLAITED" HORSE. Any age. Any type or breed of horse exceeding 148cm/14.2hh. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries.
- **"UNPLAITED" HORSE.** Any type or breed of horse exceeding Class 33 Any age. 148cm/14.2hh. To be presented hogged or natural. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. STARS points will be allocated to Hogged and Traditional Cobs
- COLOURED, SPOTTED, PALOMINO, TWO TONE INHAND, to be shown plaited, Class 34 natural or hogged. Any Age, exceeding 148cm/14.2hh. Coloureds only eligible for STARS points

RIDDEN HORSES

- Class 36 NOVICE RIDDEN. For Horses 148cm (14.2hh) and over of all types aged 4 years old and over. All 4 and 5 years olds are eligible regardless of winnings, and for 6yo and over who are eligible for Novice. (For the purposes of this show, Novice shall mean horses who have not won an Open Ridden Show Class). Riders any age. This class is open to all types: cobs (hogged or natural), hunters, hacks, riding horses, arab, coloureds, spotted, foreign etc. Please present with turnout as correct for type. Snaffle bridles permissible, but not compulsory.
- Class 37 NON-NATIVE COLOURED, SPOTTED, PALOMINO, TWO TONE HORSE. Horses exceeding 148cm/14.2hh, 4 years old or over, To be shown plaited and trimmed. Riders any age. Coloureds only eligible for STARS points
- Class 38 NATIVE, TRADITIONAL OR COB COLOURED, SPOTTED, PALOMINO, TWO TONE HORSE. Horses exceeding 148cm/14.2hh, 4 years old or over, To be shown natural or hogged and trimmed. Riders any age. *Coloureds only eligible for STARS points*
- Class 39 **EX-RACEHORSE.** Horses 4 years old or over that have raced or been in training. Riders any age.
- Class 40 **RIDING HORSE or HACK.** Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), Riders any age.
- Class 41 HUNTER. Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), Riders any age.
- Class 42 **COB or COB TYPE.** Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), to be shown hogged and trimmed, or natural. Riders any age.
- Class 43 **PURE, ANGLO or PARTBRED ARAB.** Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), Riders any age.
- Class 44 **VETERAN.** Horses 15 years old or over, any breed or type, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), Riders any age. *Class will be split by age should there be sufficient entries*
- Class 45 HEAVY HORSE or DRAUGHT BREEDS. Clydesdales, Shire, Suffolk Punch, Percheron etc. 4 years old or over. Must be registered in their relevant Stud Book as purebred Riders any age.
- Class 46 FOREIGN & RARE BREEDS. 4 years old or over. Riders any age. This class is <u>NOT</u> open to arabs or warmbloods, but to Purebred Foreign breeds such as Friesian, America Quarter Horse, Falabella, Norwegian Fjord, Haflinger etc and to breeds listed on the Rare Breed Survival Trust list. Riders any age.

- JUNIOR EQUITATION, Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st Class 50 January in the current year. Ponies/Horses 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only.
- **SENIOR EQUITATION**, Riders to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January Class 51 in the current year. Ponies/Horses 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only.
