STARS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SHOW



At the time of publishing STARS had not open up their affiliation as as places are limited there is no guarantee we will be selected as an affiliated and qualifying club and team for this year. However, we are hopeful and if successful then the Puddledub Winter, Spring, Summer & Funday Sunday Shows will all carry qualification for this fabulous four day show at Aintree in November.

Qualification would be from the highest points winner from each of 42 Categories (assuming there are no changes from Class Classifications from last year).

All the classes at this show that will gain points towards qualification have the STARS logo next to the class number. Please realise that where points are allocated in classes such as Novice, those totals will be separate to the same class category in Open etc

Points Awarded at Puddledub Shows

1 st	10 points	5 th	2 points
2 nd	8 points	6 th	1 point
3 rd	6 points	Champion	5 points
4 th	4 points	Reserve	3 points

In the case of equal points, the decision as to which horse/pony will represent Puddledub Shows will be at the discretion of the organisers/committee

Rules and Conditions of Qualification and Entry

STARS are radically revamping their rules this year, but again they were not available when we published this schedule, so they will be posted on the Puddledub DShows page and on the Puddledub Shows website www.puddledubshos.webs.com as soon as is available, and provided our membership is accepted by STARS.

STARS membership ... if you wish to accumulate points for STARS then you need to pay a £5 membership for 2023. As and when our affiliation membership is confirmed we will add a membership option to the online entries on entrymaster

Points will be gained from the following classes at this show:

CLASSES 2-12, 14-23, 25, 26, 28-33, 35, 37

First Aid Cover

After careful consideration, and following consultation with our insurance company, we will no longer provide First Aid cover in the form of an organisation at our one ring winter shows. Members of the Secretarial/Organisation team have First Aid at Work qualifications. The First Aid charge for each competitor has therefore been removed and by entering the classes and signing the entry form you have declared you have read and accepted this.

Caledonian Showing Championships



This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of









This year's show will be held at
Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 13/14/15 October 2023

Every horse & pony placed 1st in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com

There is no indoor warm-up or collecting ring at Cabin or Champfleurie so please bring plenty of warm, waterproof clothing in case of poor weather.

Hot Food and Drinks will be available at all Shows

INHAND SECTION

- Class 1 **BEST TURNED OUT INHAND.** Horses and Ponies of all breeds, ages and types. Riders any age. Will be judged on correctness of turnout for type, so plaited and unplaited are equally eligible.
- Class 2 **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND YOUNGSTOCK.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 1, 2 or 3 years old. Class will be split by age or small/large breeds if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 3 **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND ADULT.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Class will be split by small/large breeds if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 4 **“PLAITED” PONY. Show Pony, SHP, Coloured etc.** 4 years old & over. Not exceeding 148cm/14.2hh. Class will be split by age, height or type if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 5 **HORSE or PONY YOUNGSTOCK.** Hunter, Hack, Cob, Riding Horse, Warmblood/Sport Horse, SP/SHP, Coloured etc 1, 2 or 3 years old. Registered M&Ms are NOT eligible for this class. Class will be split by age or type if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 6 **“PLAITED” HORSE.** 4 years old & over. Any type or breed of horse exceeding 148cm/14.2hh. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 7 **“UNPLAITED” HORSE.** 4 years old & over. Any type or breed of horse exceeding 148cm/14.2hh. To be presented hogged or natural. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. 
STARS points will be allocated to hogged and traditional cobs
- Class 8 **COLOURED,** skewbald or piebald, to be shown plaited, natural or hogged. Any Age, will be split by age or type if there are sufficient entries. 
- Class 9 **VETERAN,** 15 years old & over. Any height or type, to be judged on conformation, movement, condition and soundness

HANDLER SECTION

Classes will be marked out of 100 as follows:

<i>Ability of the handler</i>	50
<i>Suitability of age/height of pony to handler</i>	25
<i>Overall impression</i>	25

- Class 10 **TINY TOTS HANDLER,** (supervision permitted) Handlers to have attained their 4th birthday but not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account. 





- Class 11 **YOUNG HANDLER**, Handlers to have attained their 8th birthday but not attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account. 
- Class 12 **JUNIOR HANDLER** Handlers to have attained their 12th birthday but not attained their 18th birthday by 1st January in the current year.. Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account. 
- Class 13 **ADULT HANDLER**, Handlers to have been 18 years or older at 1st January in the current year . Any type, age, size of horse/pony. Will be judged on presentation, turnout and showing skills of the handler, conformation and movement of the horse/pony will not be taken into account.

EQUITATION SECTION

Classes will be marked out of 100 as follows:

<i>Rider's use of seat and aids</i>	50
<i>Rider's position</i>	25
<i>Overall impression</i>	25

- Class 14 **LEAD REIN EQUITATION**, Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband and the leader's hand only
Rosettes to all entries. 
- Class 15 **FIRST RIDDEN EQUITATION**, Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only.
Rosettes to all entries. 
- Class 16 **JUNIOR EQUITATION**, Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies/Horses 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only. 
- Class 17 **SENIOR EQUITATION**, Riders to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies/Horses 4 years old or over and of any height and any type. Snaffle bridles only. 

EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP
open to 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 14 to 17

RIDDEN PONY SECTION

Class 18 **LEAD REIN**, 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to any type of pony; Show Pony, SHP, M&M, Coloured etc. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. Snaffle bridles only. Lead Rein to be attached to the noseband and the leader's hand only *Rosettes to all entries.*



Class 19 **FIRST RIDDEN**, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to any type of pony; Show Pony, SHP, M&M, Coloured etc. Class will be split by type if there are sufficient entries. *Rosettes to all entries.* **Any suitable bridles permitted.**



STARS points for classes 18 & 19 will be allocated into the most appropriate section ie "Plaited" or M&M LR/FR

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP

open to 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 18 & 19

Class 20 **NOVICE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B. Riders any age. Snaffle bridles only.



Class 21 **NOVICE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Section C, Welsh Section D, Fell, Dales, Highland. Riders any age. Snaffle bridles only.



Class 22 **OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Section A, Welsh Section B. Riders any age



Class 23 **OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS.** Registered Pure Bred Ponies 4 years old or over. New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Section C, Welsh Section D, Fell, Dales, Highland. Riders any age



Class 24 **NOVICE "PLAITED" PONY, Show Pony, SHP etc.** mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Class 25 **OPEN "PLAITED" PONY, Show Pony, SHP etc.** mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

open to 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 20 to 25

(INCL SOME MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES)









The Judge will not ride in any class at this show

Class 26 **BEST TURNED OUT RIDDEN.** Horses and Ponies of all breeds, ages and types. Riders any age. Will be judged on correctness of turnout for type, so plaited and



unplaited are equally eligible. If marks are used they will awarded as follows:

<i>Cleanliness, condition and correctness of tack</i>	30
<i>Cleanliness and preparation of horse/pony</i>	30
<i>Cleanliness, neatness of rider (plus handler if on lead rein</i>	30
<i>Overall impression</i>	10

- Class 27 **NOVICE RIDDEN.** For Horses 148cm (14.2hh) and over of all types aged 4 years old and over. All 4 and 5 years olds are eligible regardless of winnings, and for 6yo and over who are eligible for Novice. **(For the purposes of this show, Novice shall mean horses who have not won an Open Ridden Show Class).** Riders any age. *_This class is open to all types: cobs (hogged or natural), hunters, hacks, riding horses, arab, coloureds, spotted, foreign etc. Please present correct for type. Snaffle bridles permissible, but not compulsory.*
- Class 28 **NON-NATIVE COLOURED HORSE/PONY.** Skewbald or Piebald Horses and Ponies 4 years old or over, To be shown plaited and trimmed. Riders any age. 
- Class 29 **NATIVE, TRADITIONAL OR COB COLOURED.** Skewbald or Piebald Horses and Ponies 4 years old or over, To be shown natural or hogged and trimmed. Riders any age. 
- Class 30 **EX-RACEHORSE.** Horses 4 years old or over that have raced or been in training. Riders any age. 
- Class 31 **RIDING HORSE or HACK.** Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh), Riders any age. 
- Class 32 **HUNTER.** Horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cm (15hh), Riders any age. 
- Class 33 **COB or COB TYPE.** Horse or Pony 4 years old or over, of any height, to be shown hogged and trimmed, or natural. Riders any age. 
- Class 34 **PURE, ANGLO or PARTBRED ARAB.** Horses & Ponies 4 years old or over, any height, Riders any age.
- Class 35 **VETERAN.** Horses & Ponies 15 years old or over, any height, breed or type, Riders any age. 
- Class 36 **FOREIGN BREEDS, RARE & HEAVY BREEDS.** 4 years old or over. Riders any age. This class is **NOT** open to arabs or warmbloods, but to Purebred Foreign breeds such as Friesian, America Quarter Horse, Falabella, Norwegian Fjord, Haflinger etc, and to Purebred Breeds as currently listed on the Rare Breeds Survival Trust website: Cleveland Bay, Dales Pony, Eriskay Pony, Hackney Horse or Pony, Suffolk, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Clydesdale, Fell, Highland, Shire, New Forest 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- Class 37 **RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY.** Horse or Pony 4 years old or over, of any height, Riders any age. *STARS points will be allocate for up to 148cm (14.2hh) and over 148cm (14.2hh)*

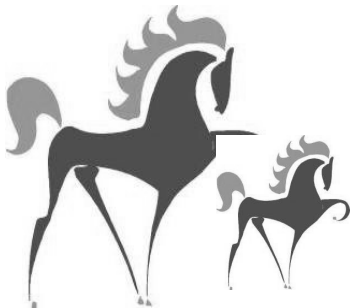
