# STARS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS SHOW



At the time of publishing STARS had not open up their affiliation as as places are limited there is no guarantee we will be selected as an affiliated and qualifying club and team for this year. However, we are hopeful and if successful then the Puddledub Winter, Spring, Summer & Funday Sunday Shows will all carry qualification for this fabulous four day show at Aintree in November.

Qualification would be from the highest points winner from each of 42 categories (assuming there are no changes from Class Classifications from last year).

All the classes at this show that will gain points towards qualification have the STARS logo next to the class number. Please realise that where points are allocated in classes such as Novice, those totals will be separate to the same class category in Open etc

## Points Awarded at Puddledub Shows

1 <sup>st</sup>	10 points	5 <sup>th</sup>	2 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	8 points	6 <sup>th</sup>	1 point
3 <sup>rd</sup>	6 points	Champion	5 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	4 points	Reserve	3 points

In the case of equal points, the decision as to which horse/pony will represent Puddledub Shows will be at the discretion of the organisers/committee

## ***Rules and Conditions of Qualification and Entry***

STARS are radically revamping their rules this year, but again they were not available when we published this schedule, so they will be posted on the Puddledub DShows page and on the Puddledub Shows website [www.puddledubshos.webs.com](http://www.puddledubshos.webs.com) as soon as is available, and provided our membership is accepted by STARS.

STARS membership ... if you wish to accumulate points for STARS then you need to pay a £5 membership for 2023. As and when our affiliation membership is confirmed we will add a membership option to the online entries on entrymaster

### **Points will be gained from the following classes at this show:**

- CLASS 1** STARS points will be gained for LEAD REIN ponies not exceeding 128cm and riders to have gained their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January but not attained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday (*points gained for the Lead Rein WHP class at STARS*)
- CLASS 2** STARS points will be gained for ponies not exceeding 128cm and riders to have not gained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday (*points gained for the Tiny Tots WHP class at STARS*)
- CLASSES 7 to 10** STARS points will be gained for ponies not exceeding 133cm and riders of any age (*points gained for the 133cm WHP class at STARS – jump height at STARS 65cm approx*) Points will be calculated separately for each height class and will not be added together
- CLASSES 8 to 10** STARS points will be gained for ponies not exceeding 153cm and riders of any age (*points gained for the 153cm WHP class at STARS – jump height at STARS 75cm approx*) Points will be calculated separately for each height class and will not be added together

**CLASSES 13 to 16** STARS points will be gained for M&M ponies not exceeding 133cm and riders of any age (*points gained for the 133cm M&M WHP class at STARS – jump height at STARS 60cm approx*) Points will be calculated separately for each height class and will not be added together

**CLASSES 14 to 16** STARS points will be gained for M&M ponies exceeding 133cm and riders of any age (*points gained for the over 133cm M&M WHP class at STARS – jump height at STARS 75cm approx*) Points will be calculated separately for each height class and will not be added together

**CLASSES 21 & 22** STARS points will be gained for horses exceeding 153cm and riders of any age (*points gained for the over 153cm Working Hunter class at STARS – jump height at STARS 85/90cm approx*) Points will be calculated separately for each height class and will not be added together

### **First Aid Cover**

**After careful consideration, and following consultation with our insurance company, we will no longer provide First Aid cover in the form of an organisation at our one ring winter shows. Members of the Secretarial/Organisation team have First Aid at Work qualifications. The First Aid charge for each competitor has therefore been removed and by entering the classes and signing the entry form you have declared you have read and accepted this.**

### **Caledonian Showing Championships**



This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of

This year's show will be held at  
***Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 13/14/15 October 2023***

Every horse & pony placed 1<sup>st</sup> in all Inhand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. ## MINI WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

- Class 1 **LEAD REIN/ASSISTED WHP**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. No age limit for riders. This class is intended for novice/nervous riders not confident to attempt a course on their own. Pony/rider combinations entered in this class will not be eligible to compete in any other class (other than 30cm class). Maximum height of fences 30cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers. **STARS points will be gained for LEAD REIN ponies not exceeding 128cm and riders to have gained their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January but not attained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday**  
*All riders who complete will receive a small prize in addition to rosettes*
- Class 2 **“PLAITED” CRADLE STAKES PONY**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 40cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers. **STARS points will be gained for ponies not exceeding 128cm and riders to have not gained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday**
- Class 3 **“PLAITED” NURSERY STAKES PONY**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 50cm
- Class 4 **M&M NURSERY STAKES**. Registered Pure-Bred Ponies 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 45cm

### “PLAITED” WORKING HUNTER PONY

*For plaited (or hogged) mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cms (approx. 15hh). RIDERS ANY AGE. There will be NO combination fences to ensure there is no issue over striding with a variety of pony heights in each class. Entries can be made in as many classes/heights as wished.*

**STARS points will be allocated as follows: Classes 7 to 10 for ponies not exceeding 133cm, Classes 8 to 10 for ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 153cm**



- Class 5 **30cm WHP**, simple fences of straight bar or cross poles, no fillers
- Class 6 **45cm WHP**, simple fences with a few fillers, nothing too scarey
- Class 7 **60cm WHP**, few more fillers
- Class 8 **75cm WHP**, more fillers and a few more questions
- Class 9 **90cm WHP**, a bit more of a challenge, but remains inviting for an early show
- Class 10 **100cm WHP**, perfect class for the more established ponies looking to compete at affiliated and qualifier level

## MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONY

*For Registered pure-bred stallions, mares or geldings. RIDERS ANY AGE. There will be NO combination fences to ensure there is no issue over striding with a variety of pony heights in each class. Entries can be made in as many classes/heights as wished.*



*STARS points will be allocated as follows: Classes 13 to 16 for ponies not exceeding 133cm, Classes 14 to 16 for ponies exceeding 133cm*

- Class 11 **30cm M&M WHP**, simple fences of straight bar or cross poles, no fillers
- Class 12 **45cm M&M WHP**, simple fences with a few fillers, nothing too scary
- Class 13 **60cm M&M WHP**, few more fillers
- Class 14 **75cm M&M WHP**, more fillers and a few more questions
- Class 15 **90cm M&M WHP**, a bit more of a challenge, but remains inviting for an early show
- Class 16 **100cm M&M WHP**, perfect class for the more established ponies looking to compete at affiliated and qualifier level

open to the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prizewinners from classes 11 to 16

## HORSE WORKER CLASSES

*Open to all types of horses, not just 'hunter' types Stallions, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153cms (approx. 15hh). RIDERS ANY AGE. There will be NO combination fences to ensure there is no issue over striding with a variety of pony heights in each class. **The judge will NOT ride.** Entries can be made in as many classes/heights as wished.*



*STARS points will be allocated in Classes 21 & 22*

- Class 17 **30cm WORKER**, simple fences of straight bar or cross poles, no fillers
- Class 18 **45cm WORKER**, simple fences with a few fillers, nothing too scary
- Class 19 **60cm WORKER**, few more fillers
- Class 20 **75cm WORKER**, more fillers and a few more questions
- Class 21 **90cm WORKER**, a bit more of a challenge, but remains inviting for an early show
- Class 22 **100cm WORKER**, perfect class for the more established horses looking to compete at open, affiliated and qualifier level

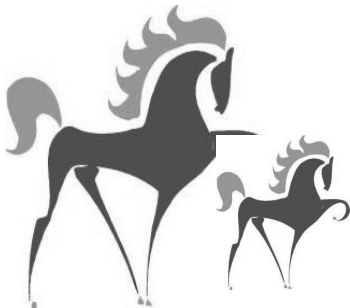
