Class 2 – NOVICE HUNTER – Open to all weights, to exceed 148cm, not to have won a first prize of £60 or a total of £200 in prize money, at any affiliated show before 1st January of the current year.

Class 3 - SHB(GB) LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER - RIHS. Mare or gelding four years old or over, capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs).

Class 4 SHB(GB) MIDDLEWEIGHT HUNTER - RIHS. Mare or gelding four years old or over, capable of carrying 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs) and not exceeding 89kgs (14 stone)

Class 5 SHB(GB) HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER - RIHS. Mare or gelding four years old or over, capable of carrying over 89kgs (14 stone).

Class 11 BSHA LIGHTWEIGHT COB - RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4 years old & over, capable of carrying up to 14 stone.

Class 12 BSHA HEAVYWEIGHT RIDING COB - RIHS. Mare or gelding exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, 4 years old & over, capable of carrying more than 14 stone.

COB CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 13 BSHA MAXI COB - RIHS. Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, exceeding 155cms. To be judged as a Cob. All Maxi Cobs should be shown hogged.

Class 17 LIHS Rising Star Lightweight Cob: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying up to 14 stone. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Lightweight Cob Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 18 LIHS Rising Star Heavyweight Cob: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying more than 14 stone. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Heavyweight Cob Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 19 LIHS Rising Star Maxi Cob: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms - to be judged as Cobs. Judges must pay particular attention to type (i.e. short legged animals of COB type). To be shown hogged. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Maxi Cob Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 20 Rising Star Racehorse to Show Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm. Open to thoroughbred and Arab horses, retired from race training. highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Racehorse to Show Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. This class is open to competitors who work within the racing industry. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 21 Small and Large Hack: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 160cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Hack Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 22 Rising Star Ladies Show Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms, suitable to carry a side saddle, to be ridden side saddle by a lady. Open to all Hacks, Cobs, Riding Horses and Hunters. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Ladies Show Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December.

Class 23 Rising Star Small Riding Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Supreme Small Riding Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 24 Large Riding Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Large Riding Horse Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. In addition two highest placed unqualified horses will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Finals at the BSHA National Championship Show in September.

Class 25 BSPS HERITAGE M&M LEAD REIN WORKING SPORTS PONY (LIHS) – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Registered Mountain and Moorland ponies not exceeding 128cms. Ridden by a child to have attained their 5th birthday on the 1st January in the current year and not to attain their 10th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Any suitable snaffle bridle. In Lead Rein WSP classes the Judges will be looking for a pony suitable for a child to begin their future in Working Sports Pony classes. Height offences approximately 30cms.

Class 26 BSPS Open Cradle Stakes – 60cms (LIHS) mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Height of fences approximately 60cms.

Class 27 BSPS Open Nursery Stakes – 75cms (LIHS) - mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Rider no to have attained their 13 th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Height of fences approximately 75cms.

Class 28 Open Working Hunter Pony – 65cm - mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. Height of fences approximately 65cms.

Class 33 TATTERSALLS ROR FORMER RACEHORSE CHALLENGE SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2024

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships, Aintree 2024 The judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge. Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'. The class to be judged 50% jumping, 20% Style while jumping and performance and 30% awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained. Voucher for a RoR branded prize to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final at Aintree on 24th August 2024.

Class 34 LIHS Rising Star Working Hunter: Open to Hunters, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms. The highest placed unqualified in the top 5 will qualify for the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Working Hunter Supreme Final at the LIHS in December. Maximum Height 95cm

Class 35 Open Working Hunter 95cm : Open to Hunters, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms.

Class 36 Open Working Hunter 105cm : Open to Hunters, mare or gelding four years old and over, exceeding 148cms.

Class 37 RIHS Open Working Hunter Qualifier 114cm – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. (Competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail). Grade A Show Jumpers and Advanced Eventers are not eligible to compete in this class. There will be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 fences. Maximum height 114cms (3'9") at the discretion of the Judge. NO change of tack or rider is allowed except if a side saddle is used, then the saddle may be changed for the Judge's ride. Exhibitors can now enter up to two horses in a working hunter class but following the jumping phase it will be up to the exhibitor to select one horse to go forward into the ridden and conformation phases if required. A skullcap or hard hat with safety harness and navy or black cover must be worn to current approved BSI or European standards during the jumping phase. No hind boots or bandages of any description are allowed in the collecting ring, warm up or in the actual class. Horses displaying continued disobedience, or horses leaving the ring mounted or dismounted will be eliminated. Horses with minus scores may not be required for the second phase of the class at the discretion of the Judge. Under no circumstances should a horse with a minus score be in a qualifying position.

Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a bitless/In-Hand Bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree, August 24th 2024 RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. Prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Class 44 - Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024 - Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. **The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23rd 2024** RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024. There is also a voucher for a RoR branded prize for the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification for the RoR Ridden Veteran Series Final at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2024. Vouchers to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Class 45 - Tattersalls RoR Open Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024 Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2024. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. **The first THREE go forward to the championship at Hickstead on June 23rd, 2024.** All entries **MUST** be competition registered with the RoR and include their competition registration number on entry form and have **RACED in GB**. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'. Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horse's last run in a race (NH or Flat) or will provide 2 ride judges should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series** RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office the winner. **The winner also qualifies** for the Tattersalls RoR Open Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024 Veteran prize (15+) - branded prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office and qualification for the RoR Ridden Veteran Final at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree 24th August 2024.
