# **GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS**

The show Is run in accordance with SHB(GB) 2023 Rules with the exception of Horse of the Year Show classes, which are run under Horse of the Year Show rules. In all HOYS classes, Horse of the Year Show rules take precedence, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk. Horses must be registered with either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Members of either SHB(GB), BSHA or TSR. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms. Classes 1 – 4, 9, & 36 - 37 are qualifiers for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 4<sup>th</sup> – 8th October 2023. These classes entitle eligible amateur combinations to earn points for the Premier Amateur League, with the opportunity of gaining a wild card place at HOYS 2023. This is open to current TSR members or those that have signed up to the Premier Amateur League 2023, for more information see <a href="https://www.theshowingregister.co.uk">www.theshowingregister.co.uk</a>. In classes 1 – 4 & 9 no horse lower than fifth will qualify. In the Championship of classes 36 - 37, no horse lower than third will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. Entries in these classes may not compete in the Small Show Hunter of the Year and vice versa.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Owners and riders of horses in all ridden classes <u>must</u> be full members of SHB(GB), unless competing on a day ticket with the exception of the Ridden Irish Draught Classes, Ridden Mare class, Ridden Cleveland Bay classes, Burghley Young Event Horse, Sport Horse Classes and Horse of the Year Show classes. Exhibitors in In Hand classes do not have to be members.

# **SAFETY / INSURANCE**

The Organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

#### **OBJECTIONS**

Objections of any kind must be made in writing, and delivered to the Secretary, within one hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, which deposit will be forfeited if the objection should prove to be frivolous. The Objector must also state the particular and precise character of his objection. All objections will be referred to the Council, whose decision will be final.

## **PRIZES**

In unsponsored ridden classes, prize money may be reduced on the following sliding scale: 3 entries - money to 1st Place only; 5 entries - money to 2nd Place only; 6 entries - money to 3rd Place only; 9 entries - money to 4th Place.

# **BROOD MARE PREMIUMS**

Brood Mare Premiums will be awarded in classes 11,15,17,19,48,53 & 55. Premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward. The premium takes the form of a rosette and Service Voucher to the value of £100, awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used in either of the two years following the year of that award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid up member of the SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

# PROGENY OF GRADED MARES

In classes 16, 18, 20, 21 - 29 incl 31, 49 – 52 incl 54, 56, 57 – 62 incl. A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed exhibit out of a SHB(GB) graded mare.

# **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

All horses eligible for championships must be forward.

# **ENTRIES - INCLUDING OPENING AND CLOSING DATE**

Entries close on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2023 at 12 noon Burghley Young Event Horse Entries open 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE - NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

Entries will not be acknowledged unless a SAE is sent to the SHB(GB) office. Numbers will be available for collection from the secretary's office at the show.

The Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.

Every effort will be made for classes not to clash, but once a classes has started a horse cannot leave the ring to compete in another class and then return to the original class.

Entries to be made online via Entrymaster - see SHB(GB) website.

All entries, except foals, must be in possession of current Influenza Vaccination Certificate and such document, which must undeniably relate to the horse in question, must accompany the animal when brought to the Show and may be examined.

All entries must be on the Society's Identity Record or Stud Book before the entry is accepted unless competing on a day ticket

or in a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier or in a class where it is specified that registration is not required - see conditions as printed on day ticket application form which is available to download from www.sporthorsegb.co.uk.

Entries in the Ridden Sport Horse classes, In Hand Irish Draught classes, Ridden Irish Draught classes, Ridden Mare class, In hand Cleveland Bay classes & Ridden Cleveland Bay classes do not have to be registered with SHB(GB) and exhibitors do not have to be members of SHB(GB), but if competing in any other classes at the show a day ticket must be purchased. Foals at foot do not have to be registered in their own right.

#### **FIRST AID**

A first aid fee of £6 per rider or In Hand exhibitor is payable at time of entry.

# **General Data Protection Regulation**

Please note that there will be a photographer on site and photographs taken may be used on the SHB(GB) website, Facebook page and may be issued to Third Party Publications for the purpose of publicising the show, results and general PR in relation to SHB(GB). In addition, class sponsors may receive pictures of awards to prize winners. If you do not want any pictures that may be taken of you/your horse utilised in this way, please make the Secretary's office at the show aware.

# Sport Horse Breeding (GB) Equine Influenza Vaccinations Policy

Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses competing in Sport Horse Breeding (GB) affiliated classes. Two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete. A first booster injection must be given within seven months after the second injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year, commencing after the first booster injection. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an EI vaccination. Foals should commence vaccinations at 6 months old.

This Rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the Sport Horse Breeding (GB) website. The current FEI ruling is for a six monthly booster as opposed to annual; therefore, it is recommended that all competitors/exhibitors/members/producers check with shows that fall under FEI regulation before entering, e.g. Windsor, Hickstead, HOYS etc.

NOTE: THE ABOVE WILL BE ENFORCED AT THE 2023 NATIONAL HUNTER SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW AND THE SOCIETY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CARRY OUT PASSPORT/VACCINATION RECORD CHECKS. ANY UNVACCINATED HORSES TOGETHER WITH ANY ANIMALS THEY ARE IN TRANSIT WITH WILL BE TURNED AWAY FROM THE SHOWGROUND

# **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES:**

All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.

All yearling, two and three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three year old colts must be un-inspected.

**Stallions** (In hand or ridden) must also be inspected and overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB)

**All RIDDEN** Pure bred Irish Draughts must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.

All owners of Pure Bred Irish Draught horses must be full members of the IDHS (GB).

All Irish Draught Sport Horse Breeding and Youngstock In Hand exhibits must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. All yearling, two and three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three year old colts must be un-inspected.

**All RIDDEN** Irish Draught Sport Horses must be in the correct ownership, have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.

All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.

Owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses do not have to be members of the IDHS (GB)

# SPORT HORSE BREEDING (GB) HOYS WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

All owners, riders & producers to be members of SHB, BSHA or TSR Horses must be registered with SHB, BSHA or TSR Small Hunters to be included in class 36. Middleweights to in class 37. Failure to jump in the correct section will result in elimination. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as of 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9ins) in height; there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The Course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray.

These classes will be judged in two parts.

Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation if so required (no change of rider is allowed). For classes 49 and 50 marks will be awarded in the following way:

PHASE I (60 MARKS)

A: JUMPING POINTS - 40 MARKS

B: STYLE WHILE JUMPING - 20 MARKS

PHASE II (40 MARKS)

C: CONFORMATION - 20 MARKS D: RIDE - 20 MARKS

In the event of equality, the CONFORMATION MARK from Phase II will take precedence, followed by the RIDE MARK, and then the STYLE MARK.

Both classes will be jumped over the same course and height. When judging the Championship, judges will use the marks they have already allocated as a guide. The highest placed unqualified horse within the top 3 of the Championship will qualify for Horse of the Year Show. These classes entitle eligible amateur combinations to earn points for the Premier Amateur League, with the opportunity of gaining a wild card place at HOYS 2023. This is open to current TSR members or those that have signed up to the Premier Amateur League 2023, for

The Championship is only open to the first and second prize winners in the lightweight and heavyweight Working Hunter classes respectively.
